**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine (“Board”), having convened on September 17, 2014, to review the petition of Stanley L. Thompson, D.V.M. (“Petitioner”), for an unconditional license as a veterinarian in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 5, 2012, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order (“2012 Order”) conditioning Petitioner’s license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota.

2. The 2012 Order required Petitioner to comply with and satisfy all requirements set forth in the 2012 Order. The 2012 Order further required Petitioner to provide the Board with evidence that he satisfied the 2012 Order.

3. The Board has reviewed and considered Petitioner’s petition and determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2012 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

ORDER

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including 2012 Order, are **RESCINDED** and have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
