Request Title Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) System Security Analysis

Request Description BCA/MNJIS serves as the host for criminal data in the State of Minnesota. These data sources must be kept secure. Additional data is exchanged with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to coordinate records of multistate criminal activity. Much of this data is classified as either public or private based on Minnesota state law and is disseminated through a number of interfaces including the public internet, walk-in requests at the BCA office, requests mailed to the BCA, and electronic requests from Minnesota criminal justice agencies, criminal justice agencies in other states and in the federal government and as otherwise authorized by state law.

The BCA Identity and Access Management system needs to migrate to the Oracle Identity and Access Management (IAM) Suite. The Identity and Access Management platform is Sun Identity Manager 8, Sun Directory Server 7 and OpenSSo Enterprise 8, which is approaching end of "Main Stream" support. The Oracle 11gR2 is a complex environment; an experienced Security Analyst Engineer is required to design and implement a solid solution.
