

eHEAT Entry for SSN Exceptions

Some individuals eligible for the Energy Assistance Program will not have a Social Security Number (SSN) entered into eHEAT. This includes eligible non-citizens, individuals participating in Minnesota’s Safe-at-Home program, religious objectors, and others with documentation listed below. This table details acceptable documentation and entry of document numbers into eHEAT:

Reason for no SSN	What to enter in applicant’s eHEAT SSN field
Safe at Home (SAH) program participant:	eHEAT automatically assigns the household a bogus SSN of SAH-XX-XXXX when the Service Provider checks the ‘Safe at Home’ checkbox on the ‘Primary Applicant’ screen.
Religious objector:	REL-ID-000X (REL=Religious, ‘ID’= SP EAP ID Number, and ‘X’ is a variable kept sequential by SP i.e. 1,2,3 in order of use)
