

Pre-Weatherization Fund Policy Manual Addendum

****Temporary Provision****

Effective February 27, 2025

1. Effective February 27, 2025 State Pre-Weatherization funds may be used to complete in-progress WAP BIL work orders that were not completed due to the February 18, 2025 WAP BIL work stoppage.
2. These funds will be used exclusively to complete outstanding work orders on jobs with WAP BIL attached that- because of policy or limited non-DOE funds- could not be completed after the work stoppage.
3. All Weatherization rules that apply to WAP BIL apply to these funds, with the following exception:
 - a. State Pre-Weatherization funds may be used to complete open work orders for jobs with WAP BIL expended even where there is no Energy Conservation Measure included on the work order.
4. These funds can be braided with EAPWX, Propane, and funds outside of Commerce's Weatherization funding (ex. Utilities or City funds).
5. The WAP BIL jobs completed with these funds may have State Pre-Weatherization funds on the job that address both deferral mitigation and completion of Weatherization.
6. DOE Formula funds may not be used on these projects (to comply with the regulation requiring Formula and WAP BIL funds remain segregated).
7. The requirement for Commerce approval to expend over \$20,000 in State Pre-Weatherization on individual projects remains intact.
8. Commerce reserves the right to vacate or adjust this policy as conditions change.

Procedure:

1. In WA, use measure type as you would for WAP BIL funding (rather than coding as Readiness as current guidance states).
2. Add a note to the audit Client Information comment box stating "this job completed using State Pre-Weatherization funds after the February 18, 2025 WAP BIL work stoppage."

Allocation

- Service Providers may use State Pre-Weatherization funds currently on their NFA for purposes outlined in this Policy Addendum for State Pre-Weatherization funds.
