TERMINOLOGY NOTICE

The terminology used to describe people we serve has changed over time. Direct Care and Treatment (DCT) supports the use of "People First" language.

Backround

The Direct Care and Treatment (DCT) agency calculates interim charges on a per diem basis each fiscal year by dividing the sum of all anticipated costs by the funded bed capacity. Rates are an average of all services provided by each program.

Effective Aug. 1, 2025, the charges for care are as follows:
