

TERMINOLOGY NOTICE

The terminology used to describe people we serve has changed over time. Direct Care and Treatment (DCT) supports the use of "People First" language.

Background

Minnesota Statutes, Section 246B.10 clarifies a county's financial responsibility for clients of the Minnesota Sex Offender Program (MSOP) who are provisionally discharged.

Provisional Discharge Rates

Cost of care charges for clients provisionally discharged from MSOP consist of two components:

1. Housing
2. Supervision and treatment.

Charges will be calculated based on the services provided to individual clients. The county of financial responsibility will be notified of individual client rates. Rates will be effective August 1, 2025.

Housing Services

Housing services are primarily provided by non-state vendors and may include residential services, such as supervised apartments, adult foster care, halfway house or other living and housing arrangements with client activity monitoring. Rates are based on contractual agreements with vendors and are offset by payments received directly by the vendor from Medical Assistance or other payer sources. Rates may range from \$0 to \$450 per day.

Supervision and Treatment

Supervision services are provided by Minnesota Sex Offender Program (MSOP) staff as required by court order and DCT policy. Supervision includes case management, transportation as needed, GPS tracking, and drug and alcohol testing. Treatment services are provided by community providers on an outpatient basis and range from one to two days per week to one day a month. Rates are based on the level of risk and client needs as they progress through a five-tier program. Rates for supervision and treatment are:

- Tiers 1 and 2: \$120.00 per day
- Tier 3: \$88.00 per day
- Tiers 4 and 5: \$57.00 per day
