Meeting Notes

Opening Introductions

I. Introductions from task force members and guests

Recommendations from Workgroup 1 and Workgroup 2

- I. Workgroup 1 (Objectives 1 and 2)
 - a. Friends and Family Survey that was completed
 - b. The workgroup has complied a draft document but has not yet finalized it to ensure accuracy and coherence
 - c. Data on commitment trends was discussed
 - d. The group examined national trends
 - i. The workgroup acknowledged the complexities and trade-offs of Minnesota's system, recognizing the need for further discussion to refine recommendations. The next steps involve reviewing the compiled information, ensuring clarity in language, and finalizing key takeaways
 - e. The group will meet again to refine the draft before forwarding recommendations to other workgroups.
- II. Workgroup 2 (Objectives 5 and 6)
 - a. Members reviewed data from various surveys and identified gaps, particularly in judicial and examiner input. Key discussions focused on the need for a state-run facility to address

- placement challenges, provide stabilization, and serve as an alternative to finalized MI&D commitments.
- b. The workgroup also explored ways to improve discharge processes, enhance case management, and ensure continuity of care, especially in jails.
- c. The workgroup discussed the need to have one to two additional meetings to refine recommendations and finalize the report.

Discussion of Other Workgroups

The group decided to form a single drafting workgroup to handle statutory changes for Objectives 3, 5, 7, 8, and 9. Current workgroups will first complete their reports before transitioning to drafting legislative updates. Objective 7 will continue its discussions before merging into the drafting process, while Objectives 8 and 9 will be addressed together to ensure consistency. This approach allows for thorough review and consensus before drafting begins, streamlining recommendations for legislative changes.
