- 3. What are concerns or considerations regarding a shift in practice to serve individuals civilly committed as mentally ill and dangerous in the community?
- 4. What are the barriers to discharge from the forensic mental health program?
- 5. What are recommendations to reduce barriers to discharge from the forensic mental health program?
- 6. What are the barriers to county case managers providing case management and meeting statutory requirements following discharge from the forensic mental health program?
- 7. Of those individuals currently experiencing a mentally ill and dangerous commitment type through your county, what is the percentage of individuals who were known to your agency prior to that level of involvement?
- 8. Are there services or changes to the process that could have prevented these same individuals from reaching the need of a mentally ill and dangerous commitment type?
