EQB is currently leading an interagency working group to develop Minnesota's 2025 Groundwater Policy Report, a required legislative report on the state's groundwater protection programs, due in September 2025. Our goal is for the report to support informed decision making on groundwater issues by:

- Providing foundational information about groundwater in Minnesota
- Describing the state's collaborative approach to protecting groundwater
- Describing important threats to Minnesota's groundwater and the actions being taken to mitigate those threats
- Identifying important gaps and opportunities to be addressed
