

**Point Source Implementation Grant Program
FY 2019 Applicants**

The Point Source Implementation Grant (PSIG) program provides grants to local governments to help with the cost of water infrastructure projects necessary to meet wasteload reduction requirements under Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) implementation plans, to reduce the discharge of phosphorus or meet other water quality-based effluent limits, or to meet a total nitrogen concentration or mass limit that requires a discharge of ten milligrams per liter or less. The PSIG program provides grants for 80% of eligible costs up to a maximum of \$7,000,000. Projects must be listed on the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's (MPCA) Project Priority List (PPL).

PSIG applicants are listed below in priority order based on MPCA's 2019 PPL, beginning with projects that previously applied and were certified by MPCA by June 30, 2018, followed by new applications received in July 2018. A project must receive MPCA approval and certification of the PSIG eligible construction costs and submit as-bid project costs to the PFA to receive a PSIG grant. To the extent grant funds are available, PFA will reserve funds when a project is certified based on the project cost estimate at that time or the as-bid costs, whichever is less. PSIG grants are awarded to certified projects when as-bid costs are submitted and any other necessary funding is secured.

Projects that are certified by June 30, 2019 but do not receive FY 2019 grants awards, either because they have not completed the bidding process or because grant funds are not available, will be listed the following year with other certified projects in priority order, before new project applications in priority order. Applicants whose projects do not receive MPCA certification by June 30, 2019 may reapply in July 2019.

As of July 1, 2018 the PFA has \$18,551,858 available for PSIG grants from pre-2018 appropriations, including Clean Water Legacy Funds. Additionally, the 2018 Legislature appropriated \$38,348,000 for PSIG grants from Special Appropriation Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund Bonds that are expected to be available later in the year. The PFA will use available funds to award PSIG grants to eligible projects in priority order, beginning with the FY 2018 certified projects. The dashed lines below indicate the fundable range of projects based on the reserved and estimated grant amounts. The first dashed line (---) indicates the last estimated grant to be fully funded from current available (pre-2018) funds. The second dashed line (---) indicates the last estimated grant to be fully funded from the 2018 appropriation bond funds, if the eligible applicants proceed with their projects and receive MPCA certification by June 30, 2019.
