





### CareerForce.MN.gov sprint review

### What is a sprint review?

- A demonstration of the work that the product team has completed over a specific period
  - This can include new features, bug fixes, and changes to how the product (in this case, CareerForce.MN.gov) functions
- A time to ask questions and give feedback to the product team

## What we accomplished: Sprint 135

#### Preparation for back-end upgrade:

- Enabled the base theme for the site so we will not have to rely on additional modules when upgrading
- ✓ Added default templates to the site theme to maintain consistent styling across the site when upgrading
- ✓ Disabled a module that was causing issues with focus states and aria labels
- Evaluated a module issue that was causing navigation issues for screen readers
- ✓ Confirmed the correction of an issue that was preventing users from reaching Part 2 of account registration in one of our new test environments

Preparation for .gov URL cutover:

 Made necessary updates to Google Analytics and Tag Manager to confirm that they work under .gov domain

Bug fixes:

- ✓ Addressed an issue that was causing CareerForce.MN.gov to distinguish email addresses by case
- Updated Military Career Lookup tool to resolve a display issue in one of our new test environments
- ✓ Fixed an issue that was causing a module error in one of our new test environments

### What we accomplished: Sprint 136

#### Preparation for .gov URL cutover:

- Transitioned to an updated file system for CareerForce.MN.gov
- Corrected an issue that was preventing the Download Resume button from working in our test environment
- Addressed a Javascript issue that was preventing the My Labor Market tab from displaying as expected in our test environment
- Whitelisted the CareerForce.MN.gov URL with CareerOneStop to ensure that occupation videos and other API features display as expected
- ✓ Fixed a button styling issue for Groups in our test environment

Preparation for back-end upgrade:

- ✓ Cleaned up old modules to update base theme of the site
- ✓ Patched a known issue that was causing CareerForce.MN.gov to distinguish email addresses by case
- ✓ Addressed an error that was impacting ability to edit Group content
- ✓ Addressed an error that was impacting Group list pages
- ✓ Corrected an issue that was preventing emails from being sent to Group Managers when a new Staff/Partner account checks the "Join CareerForce" box on their account page
- ✓ Fixed an error that was impacting the "Manage Availability" action for administrative accounts in Groups
- ✓ Accessibility fix: Removed duplicate IDs and added an accessible name to the icon in the general site search



### What we accomplished: Sprint 136, continued

Resume feature (deployed to Sandbox):

- ✓ Reviewed user permissions for feature testing
- ✓ Created a Master Resume entity type
- ✓ Created a Tailored Resume entity type
- ✓ Built functionality for master resume content tabs:
  - ✓ Contact Info
  - ✓ Summary
  - ✓ Skills
  - ✓ Experience
  - ✓ Education
- ✓ Refined the text format for Resume Builder fields

- Confirmed the scope of the Skills section
- ✓ Refined the scope of the Education section
- ✓ Built the page layout for resume workflow steps
- ✓ Set up navigation functionality between resume workflow steps
- ✓ Set up resume workflow progress sidebar
- Completed field updates across all Resume Builder steps

### What we accomplished: Sprint 136, continued further!

Back end:

- ✓ Made Decision Tree cards responsive images to improve site performance
- ✓ Researched key tasks and questions related to Employer accounts on CareerForce.MN.gov

Bug fixes:

- ✓ Corrected an issue that was preventing some users from accessing their dashboards when logging in
- ✓ Cleaned up permission-related errors from the previous Decision Tree functionality
- ✓ Accessibility fix: Added a focus state to arrows in carousels such as Upcoming Events and Upcoming Training Programs
