

Electric Generation Transition Aid

Minnesota Statute 477A.24


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Purpose of the Statute

Goal: Provide financial support to local governments when a coal, nuclear, or gas electric generating unit is retired and removed from the tax base

Why it matters: Retirement reduces tax capacity, affecting local budgets

Key Definitions



Electric generating unit: A single coal, nuclear or gas-powered generator

Electric generation property: Taxable property of the electric plant

Eligible taxing jurisdiction: County, city, town, or school district

Unit base year: Year when a generating unit is reduced in value

Unit differential: Drop in tax capacity due to retirement

Notification

Who: Public Utilities

What: Notify the Commissioner of Revenue of unit retirement

When: Along with regular reporting (Sec. 273.371)



To Qualify

Unit Differential


- The tax capacity of electric generation property in the year preceding the base year needs to be 4% or greater
- The unit differential is the difference in the electric generating plant's NTC in the year prior to retirement minus the NTC in the unit base year.

Calculating the Aid

- Initial Unit Transition Amount:
 - Formula: Unit Differential x Tax Rate (unit base year)
- Ongoing Payments:
 - Each following year: reduced by 5% annually
 - Ends if amount falls below \$5,000

Aid Elimination

Minnesota's coal plants




• When aid stops:

When the jurisdiction's net tax capacity equals 90% of the net tax capacity in the year preceding the year in which the jurisdiction first qualified for aid.

Administration & Payment

Commissioner's role: Calculate, certify, and distribute aid
