2018 Minnesota BUSINESS EXPANSION PROJECTS BY THE NUMBERS

MINNESOTA: THRIVING IN THE NORTH

From startups to global giants, Minnesota is able to grow businesses of all sizes across a diverse mix of industries. Minneapolis-St. Paul ranked first per capita in Fortune 500s in 2018 – and Minnesota ranked third. The state also ranked third in five-year survival of new businesses (2013-2018, Bureau of Labor Statistics).

What attracts and keeps businesses here? Key factors include workforce quality, the robust education system, a culture of technology and innovation, strong infrastructure and top-ranking quality of life.

Minnesota's healthy business climate is apparent from national rankings. CNBC named Minnesota a top 10 state for business 10 times between 2007 and 2018 and ranked it first and third in 2015 and 2017.

State policies and programs encourage business growth. The Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) administers a broad range of resources that include loan and grant programs, tax credits and worker training partnerships – most of which leverage private investments. Among them:

➤ **Minnesota Small Business Development Centers** provide free consultations and business assistance through a network of nine regional centers and 19 satellite offices across the state.

- **Minnesota Innovation Loans for Entrepreneurs (MILE)** provide interest-free loans ranging from \$20,000 to \$50,000 to early-stage businesses that are developing high-tech products or services in Minnesota. Other programs geared toward entrepreneurs include the **Angel Loan Fund** as well as the **Minnesota Emerging Entrepreneur Loan Program**.
- The **Minnesota Job Creation Fund** is a pay-for-performance program that provides funding to businesses after they meet certain criteria. Since 2014, more than \$43 million has been awarded for 95 business expansion projects across the state.
- The **Minnesota Investment Fund** awards low-interest loans that businesses can use for improving their operations and hiring additional workers.
- **Minnesota Jobs Skills Partnership** provides various grants for training new and existing employees of participating businesses. Since 2011, it has awarded over \$57 million to train about 70,000 workers.


These programs are part of a supportive ecosystem that encourages business startups and growth – giving rise to the 226 business expansion projects tracked by DEED in 2018 – an increase of 24% over the previous year. 2018 Minnesota BUSINESS EXPANSION PROJECTS

Alula

ST. PAUL

Alula is a home security technology company that offers hardware and software for professional security alarm dealers. Alula will be moving its headquarters and production center from Hudson, Wis., to the Midway area of St. Paul and will renovate an existing facility. The move is expected to create 135 jobs within the next three years and to cost about \$1.8 million. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Bondhus

MONTICELLO

Bondhus Corp. is a majority woman-owned firm that manufactures a wide range of hand tools. Bondhus is expected to create 15 new jobs in Monticello within the next three years. The company plans to invest \$2.3 million to build a 12,600-square-foot addition and make other site improvements for a new product line. The company's tools are sold in more than 100 countries across the globe. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Cantel Medical

PLYMOUTH

Cantel Medical Corp. is a leading provider of infection prevention and control products and services in the health care market. The company plans to renovate and expand its Plymouth facility to add a 20,000-square-foot innovation and training center and a 7,500-square-foot research and development testing center. The expansion project is expected to create 101 jobs within three years and to cost about \$4.5 million. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*

Delta Dental (Stratacor)

BEMIDJI

Delta Dental of Minnesota, a subsidiary of Stratacor Inc., is an independent, nonprofit health services company that provides oral health care in Minnesota and North Dakota. It broke ground on a new operations and technology center in Bemidji in August 2018. The center is expected to create up to 150 new jobs and to cost about \$13 million. Delta Dental credited the expansion to recent and projected membership growth, new product offerings and the development of technology infrastructure. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Investment Fund award.*

GEOTEK

STEWARTVILLE

GEOTEK specializes in manufacturing fiberglass composite products, including composite fencing products and PUPI® crossarms for the electric utility industry. The company plans to invest \$5.8 million to purchase and renovate a 66,000-square-foot building and 20 acres of land adjacent to its existing facility in Stewartville, and to acquire equipment for production at the new facility. GEOTEK expects to create at least 62 jobs within five years. *DEED supported this project with Minnesota Investment Fund and Job Creation Fund awards.*

Graco

ROGERS

Graco, an internationally recognized manufacturer of fluid-handling equipment for industrial and commercial applications, plans to create 84 jobs over the next four years and invest more than \$73 million to expand its operations in Rogers at the David A. Koch Center. The project will add 480,000-square-foot to the existing 316,000-square-foot manufacturing, office and product development facility. The facility employs more than 450 people. Graco also operates a distribution facility in Rogers that employs over 160 people. *DEED supported this project with Minnesota Investment Fund and Job Creation Fund awards.*





PROJECT SNAPSHOT: DAIKIN APPLIED AMERICAS

Company: Daikin Applied Americas
Headquarters: Plymouth, Minn.
Project location: Faribault
Industry: HVAC manufacturing
Investment: \$40.3 million

Daikin Applied Americas makes heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems for the commercial market. Based in Plymouth, Minn., the firm operates two plants in Minnesota – in Owatonna and Faribault – which employ about 900 people.

When the company realized it needed more production capacity, it considered multiple locations inside and outside the United States – but it opted for the highly skilled labor market of southern Minnesota. In fact, it selected the same location where it already had a plant: Faribault, a city of about 24,000 people that's located 50 miles south of Minneapolis-St. Paul.

Daikin Applied is a division of Daikin Industries, based in Japan, which is the world's largest HVAC manufacturer, with over 90 production sites worldwide.

Now, Daikin Applied is acquiring a 300,000-square-foot warehouse in Faribault and renovating it into a state-of-the-art manufacturing facility that will employ more than 200 people. Total projected cost is \$40.3 million – and the company plans to create at least 132 new jobs within five years that will pay an average wage of \$22.20 per hour.

“We have grown our operation within the city of Faribault over 50 years. In 2000, we opened the Owatonna factory, and completed a major expansion there in 2014, to triple its size,” said Daikin Vice President and General Manager Will Fort, who leads operations at both Minnesota plants.

“Our strong growth in recent years is the result of having highly skilled people in the plants, expert product design and marketing teams in our Plymouth headquarters, and the commitment from Daikin Industries to manufacturing excellence,” he added.

Daikin Applied CEO Mike Schwartz said: “We’re appreciating the cooperation and assistance of the civic leaders in St. Paul and southern Minnesota to help make this happen.”

DEED is supporting the expansion with a \$750,000 loan from the Minnesota Investment Fund and a \$1.6 million award from the Job Creation Fund.

Heliene

MOUNTAIN IRON

Heliene, which makes solar panels in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, opened a solar panel manufacturing operation in Mountain Iron, Minn., in 2018. The highly automated, 25,000-square-foot factory is able to produce 1,300 solar panels a day, mostly for use in larger commercial and utility-scale installations. It employs about 120 people. *The company received a \$3.5 million loan package from the state, with half from the Department of Iron Range Resources & Rehabilitation and half from DEED.*

Maple Island

WANAMINGO


Maple Island Inc. is a food powder processing and packaging company founded in the 1930s that is expanding its production site in Wanamingo. The project is expected to cost \$900,000 and to create 20 new jobs. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Investment Fund award.*



Mortarr, LLC

ALBERT LEA

Mortarr is a majority woman-owned software business startup specializing in the commercial construction and design industry. For its headquarters, the company plans to renovate space it purchased in a historic building in downtown Albert Lea. The project is estimated to cost more than \$1 million and to create 34 jobs within the next two years. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Pinnacle Climate Technologies

SAUK RAPIDS

Pinnacle Climate Technologies is a global developer, manufacturer, marketer and distributor of heating and ventilation products that serve industrial, commercial, horticulture, agriculture, rental and retail industries. Pinnacle plans to relocate to a newly renovated 122,000-square-foot facility in Sauk Rapids. The project is expected to cost \$1.2 million and to create 10 jobs within three years. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Expanding Industries Invest in Minnesota



Minnesota has seen the number of annual business expansion projects tracked by DEED rise from 182 projects in 2017 to 226 projects in 2018. These expansions are spread across the state and involve more than 40 industries, but two areas in particular – manufacturing and computer-related industries – led the way for growth in 2018. Here are a few highlights.

Food and beverage manufacturing saw 19 expansion projects in 2018, with businesses committed to adding at least 880 new jobs – many in Greater Minnesota – and investing more than \$97 million in facilities and equipment. For example, two large food producers – Buddy’s Kitchen in Lakeville and Premium Iowa Pork in Luverne – each planned to add 300 or more jobs. Breweries and distilleries across the state announced expansion projects.

A global leader in medical devices, Minnesota saw 17 **medical equipment manufacturing** expansions in 2018 that are expected to result in around 600 new jobs. Among them were IntriCon Corp.’s expansion in Arden Hills, with 150 new jobs, and Cantel Medical’s expansion in Plymouth, with 101 new jobs over a three-year period.

Meanwhile, 14 expansion projects in **machinery manufacturing** are slated to add about 580 jobs and over \$141 million in investment across the state. The largest of these was a new Daikin Applied plant in Faribault which entails 200 new jobs over a three-year period (see page 5).

Plastics and rubber products manufacturing is growing. Up North Plastics’ expansion in Cottage Grove is expected to add 200 jobs, and Protolabs’ expansion in Brooklyn Park, another 139 jobs. In total, the eight expansion projects announced in 2018 are expected to

result in upwards of 600 new jobs and investments of at least \$175 million.

Computer-related industries – including computer programming/design services and computers and electronics manufacturing – had more than 20 business expansion projects in 2018, representing more than 450 new jobs.

GROWTH IN SMALL AND EMERGING FIRMS

Expansions aren’t limited to medium and large companies; small firms and startups are attracting investments and expanding operations as well.

A few examples include finance and insurance-related technology startups such as Sezzle and ClickSWITCH – both of which announced plans in 2018 to double their staffs – as well as health care technology and medical device companies such as OmniTier, NovuHealth, Sansoro Health and Relieva Medsystems, which moved from California to Minnesota last year.

Minnesota ranked second in the Midwest – and 15th overall – in venture capital investment in 2018 (PwC/CB Insights MoneyTree™). While innovators and entrepreneurs are leading the way, DEED is committed to helping expand the state’s innovation economy by providing startups and more established businesses with a broad range of assistance and information.

Protolabs

BROOKLYN PARK

Protolabs is a leading digital manufacturer for rapid prototyping and on-demand production, producing custom parts and assemblies with automated 3D printing, CNC machining, sheet metal fabrication and injection molding processes. It is investing \$29.9 million to acquire, renovate and expand a 152,000-square-foot building in Brooklyn Park. The expansion will house 225 people from the company's Plymouth facility and another expected 139 new workers. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Stoneridge Software

BARNESVILLE

Stoneridge Software Inc., a business technology firm and Microsoft Gold Partner, decided to relocate its corporate office to the newly renovated historic T. Guinness Building in downtown Barnesville, about 25 miles southeast of Fargo-Moorhead. The company is investing \$725,000 to expand its operations to 7,500 square feet of newly renovated office space. As part of a state grant, Stoneridge committed to hiring seven new employees in Barnesville within two years. The company – which also has offices in Minneapolis and Fargo – says it hired 56 people (including interns and remote workers) in 2018. *DEED supported this project with a Minnesota Job Creation Fund award.*



Windings

NEW ULM

Windings Inc. is a leader in the design, testing, manufacturing and support of custom electric motors, generators and related components for a broad range of industries. The company announced plans to purchase a 60,000-square-foot facility in New Ulm, where it is headquartered, and then renovate and add an additional 10,000-square-feet to the building. The project is expected to cost \$7.9 million and to create 20 jobs within three years. *DEED supported this project with Minnesota Investment Fund and Job Creation Fund awards.*





PROJECT SNAPSHOT: UPONOR NORTH AMERICA

Company: Uponor North America
Headquarters: Apple Valley
Project locations: Hutchinson, Apple Valley
Industry: Plastics manufacturing
Investment: 11 expansions in Minnesota since 1990

Uponor North America began production of PEX piping at its new manufacturing facility in Hutchinson, Minn., in May 2018. Initially announced in 2017, the 237,000-square-foot facility was purchased, renovated and received regulatory approval in less than a year, according to the company.

The company invested more than \$32 million in buying and renovating the facility, and it anticipates creating about 140 jobs over the next several years.

“While this is our latest expansion, it is certainly not our last. We are grateful to Hutchinson and community leaders for their support,” said Bill Gray, president of Uponor North America. “We look forward to remaining part of the community for years to come.”

The opening of the plant marked Uponor’s 11th expansion in Minnesota since 1990. Previous expansions were on the company’s North American headquarters campus in Apple Valley, Minn. Uponor North America employs more than 600 people in Minnesota.

Uponor makes pipes for residential and commercial uses, including plumbing, fire safety, radiant heating and cooling, hydronic piping and pre-insulated piping systems. It has received recognition for best-in-class manufacturing, sustainability, energy efficiency, safety, business growth, economic development, workplace giving and being a top workplace.

Uponor’s global headquarters is in Vantaa, Finland. It employs more than 4,000 people worldwide.

Over the years, DEED has supported the company’s various expansions with grants and forgivable loans from its Job Creation Fund and Minnesota Investment Fund.

DEED is supporting the expansion in Hutchinson with a \$450,000 loan from the Minnesota Investment Fund and a \$1.48 million award from the Job Creation Fund.
