

Line Extension Connection Program Speed Test Information

As part of the *Line Extension Connection Program* grant agreement, grantees must provide Project-level data for the following measures at completion of the project. Listed below is additional information regarding what will be evaluated and needed to be submitted to complete closeout of the grant project.

Note: A minimum of 10% of the locations, evenly dispersed throughout the project area(s), will need supporting evidence as outlined below, however your Grant Administrator will confirm the total amount and/ or any specific locations.

Download Speed Test	<p>LECP requires <i>download</i> delivery speeds that meet or exceed 100 Megabits per second (Mbps). Download speed tests should be based on the grant requirement.</p> <p>To satisfy the requirement the results need to be within 80% of the highest speed available, as reported on the Location Data Sheet.</p>
Upload Speed Test	<p>LECP requires <i>upload</i> delivery speeds that meet or exceed 100 Megabits per second (Mbps). Download speed tests should be based on the grant requirement.</p> <p>To satisfy the requirement the results need to be within 80% of the highest speed available, as reported on the Location Data Sheet.</p>
Latency Test	<p>Latency tests should be based on the federal requirement, less than 100 Milliseconds.</p> <p>The results need to be less than the requirement to be considered satisfactory.</p>
