Minnesota Job Skills Partnership Program

\$	Automation Training Incentive Program (ATIP)	Up to \$35,000 to small businesses (under 150 employees) that are implementing new automation for training incumbent workers on the automation technology.
***	Job Training Incentive Program (JTIP)	Up to \$200,000 to new or expanding businesses in greater MN that are adding at least three new jobs.
181	MN Job Skills Partnership (MJSP) Partnership Program	Up to \$500,000 to educational institutions that partner with businesses to develop new-job training or retraining for existing employees.
	Pathways Program	Up to \$400,000 to educational institutions or nonprofit organizations that partner with businesses to provide training, new jobs and career paths for low-income people
	Low Income Worker Training Program	Up to \$200,000 to public, private, or nonprofit entities to help low-income people gain new skills necessary move up the career ladder to higher paying jobs and greater economic self-sufficiency

Other Employer Programs

- Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Federal tax credit available to all businesses as an incentive to hire workers in certain groups.
- <u>Federal Bonding Program</u> Fidelity Bonding is a no-cost employee dishonesty insurance that protects employers against employee theft of money or property.
- Internship Programs Targeted tax credits and incentives for high-tech firms statewide and other companies in Greater Minnesota
- <u>Employer Reasonable Accommodation Fund</u> Small to mid-sized employers can request reimbursement for expenses related to providing reasonable accommodations for job applicants and employees with disabilities
