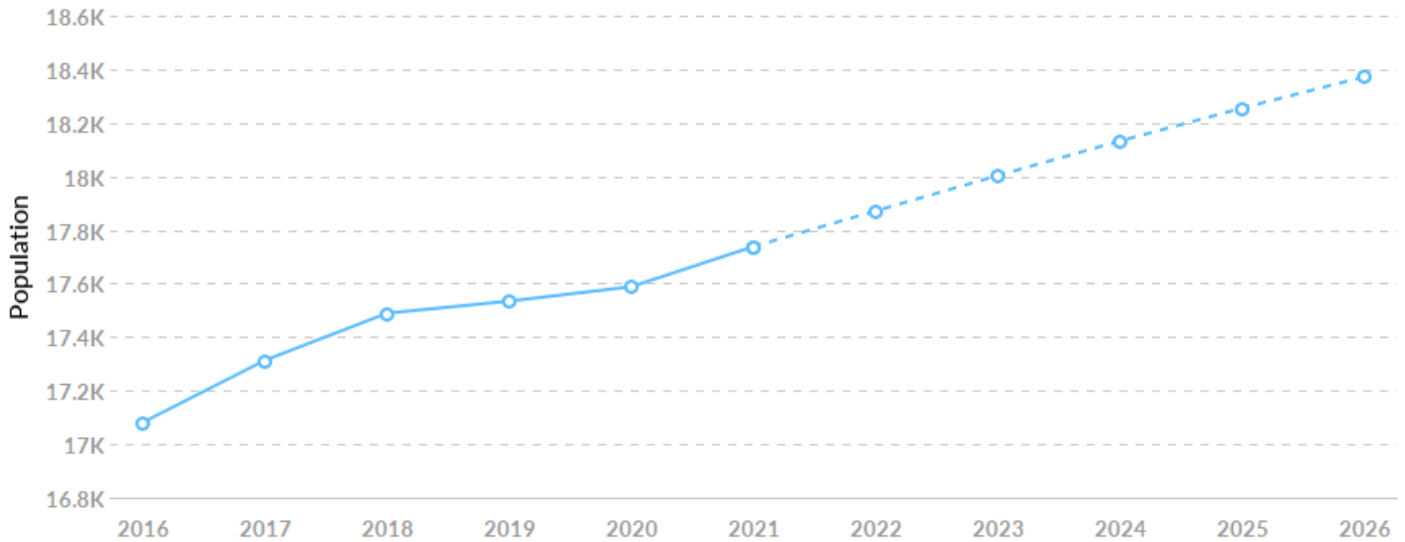

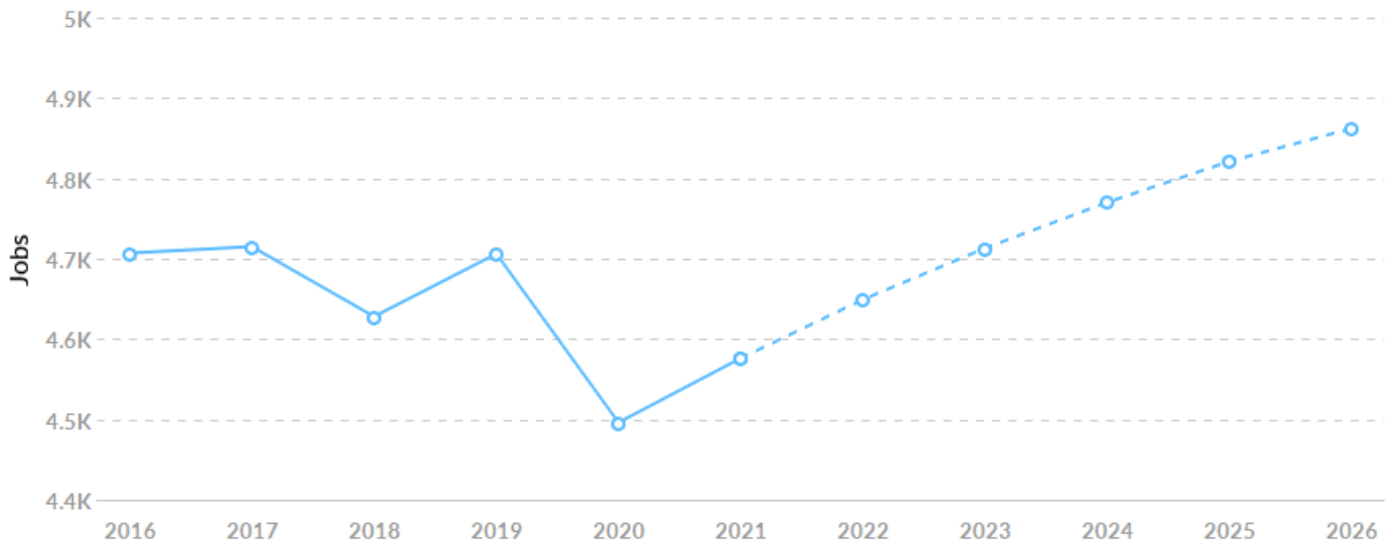

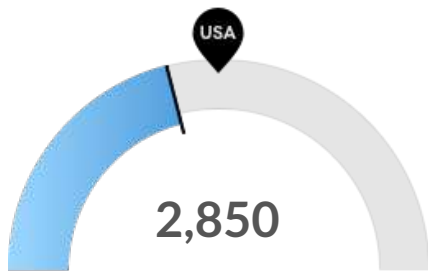
Job Trends

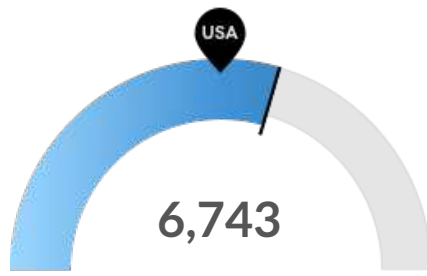

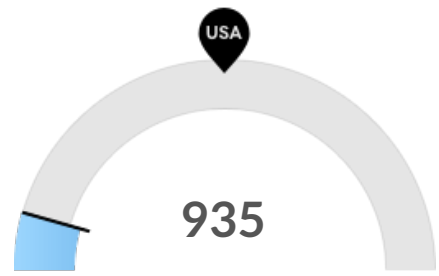
Millennials

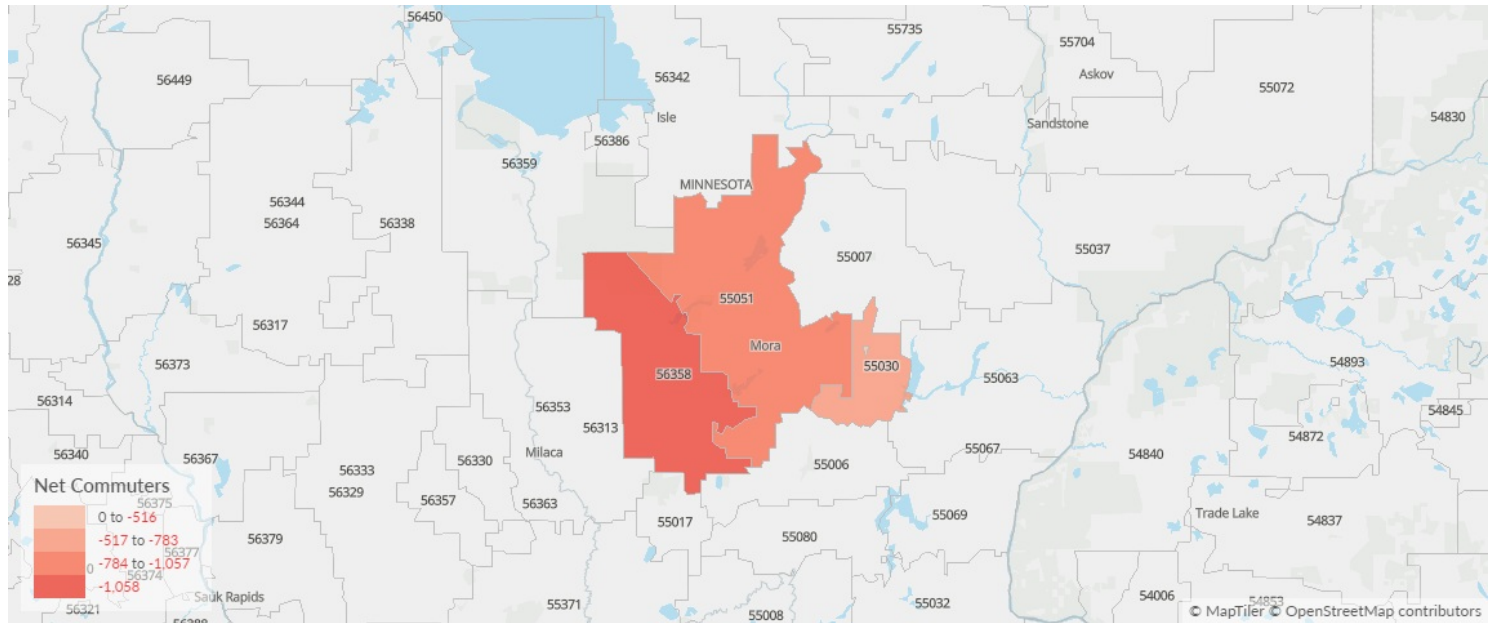

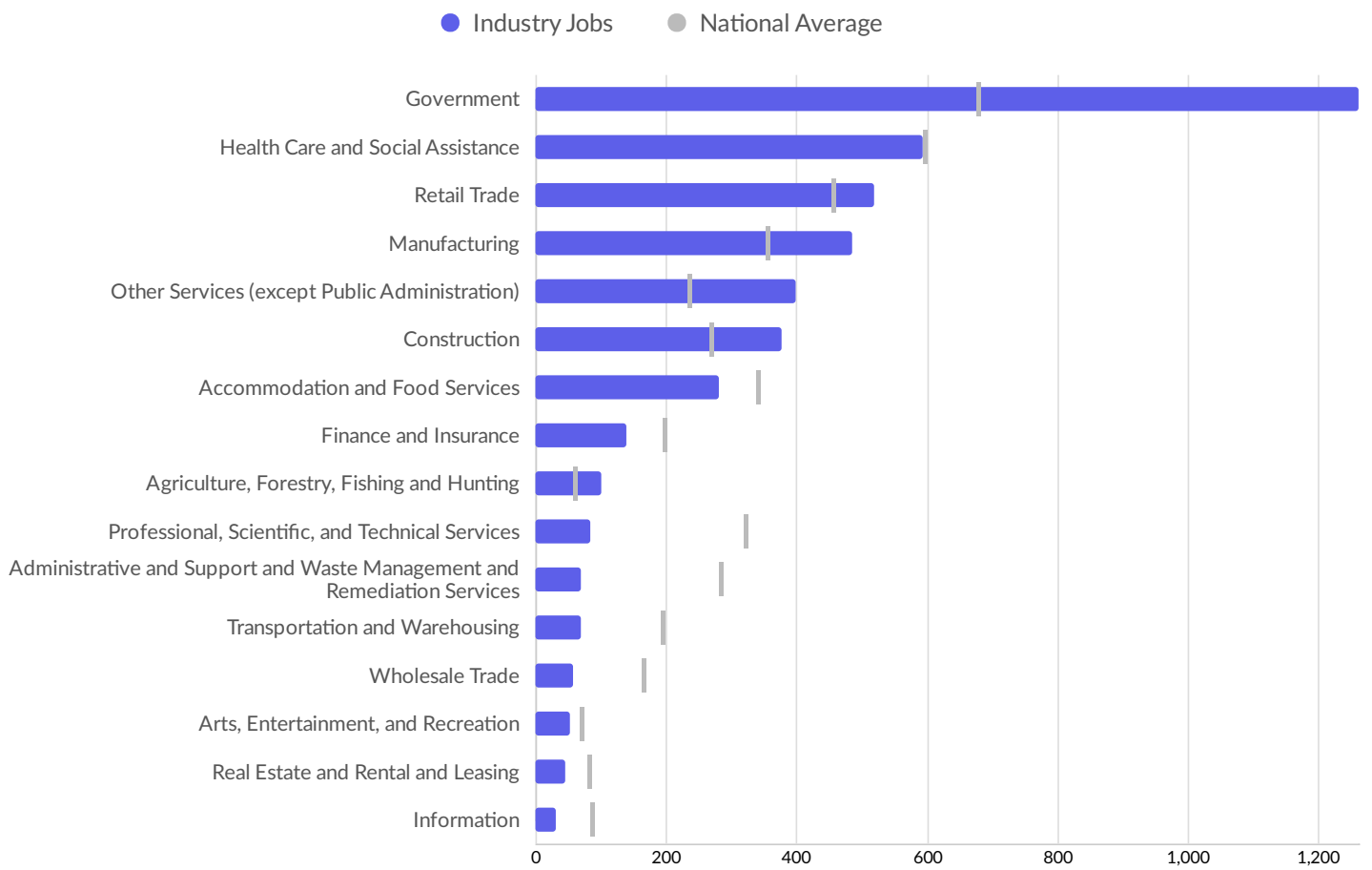

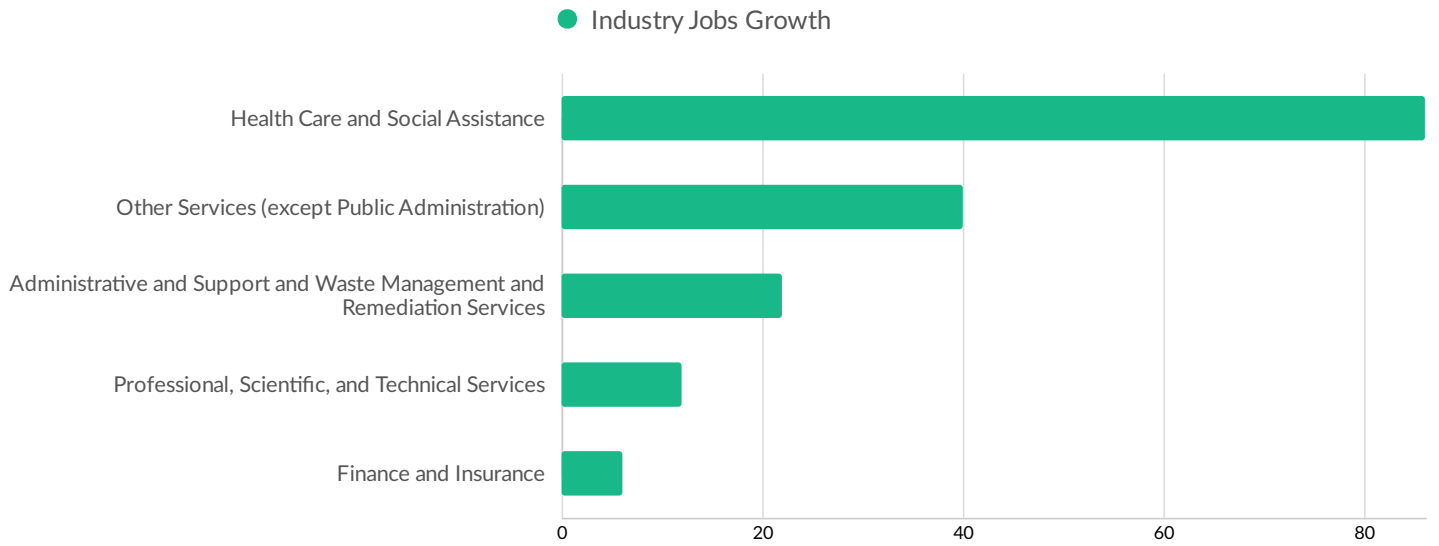

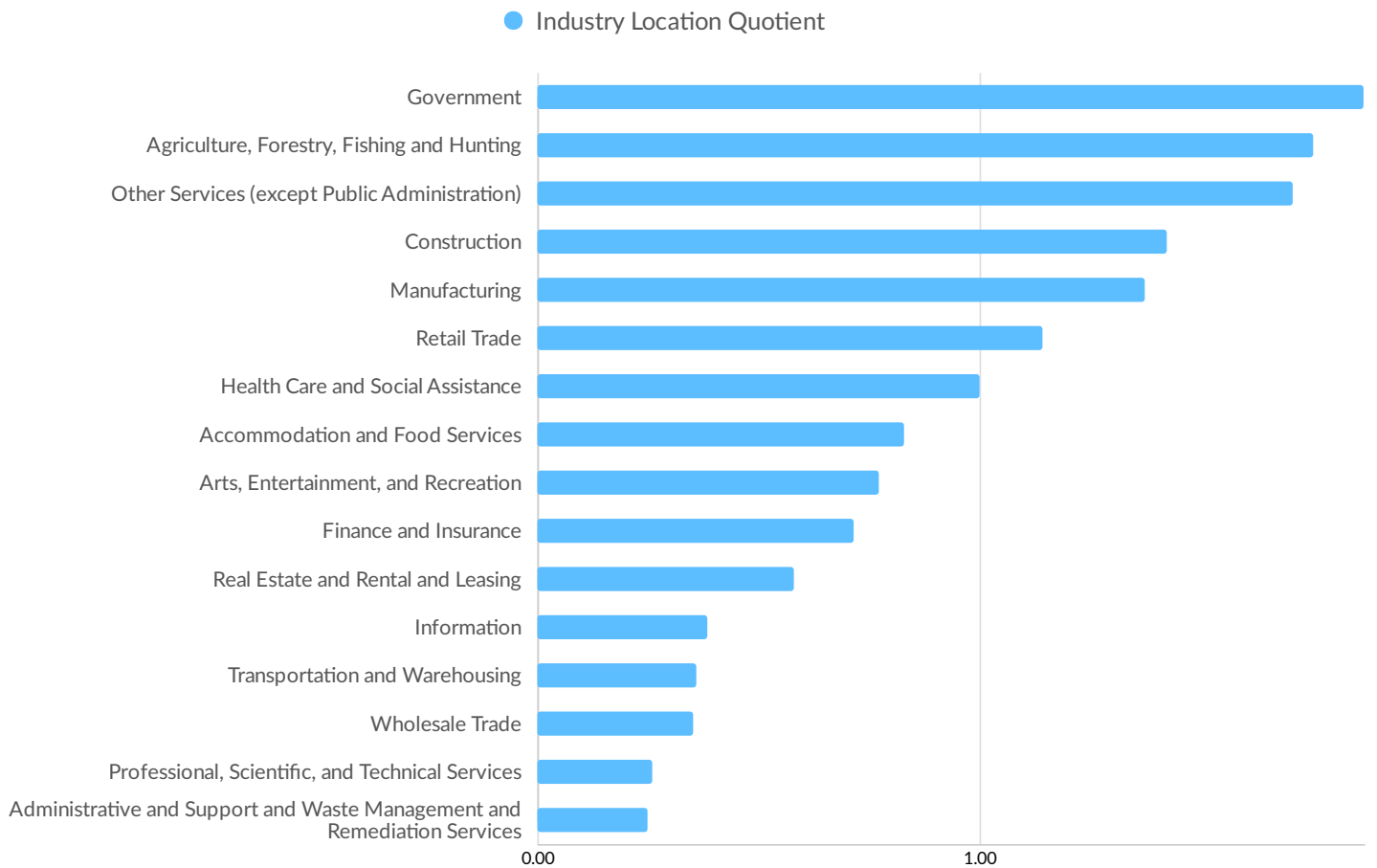

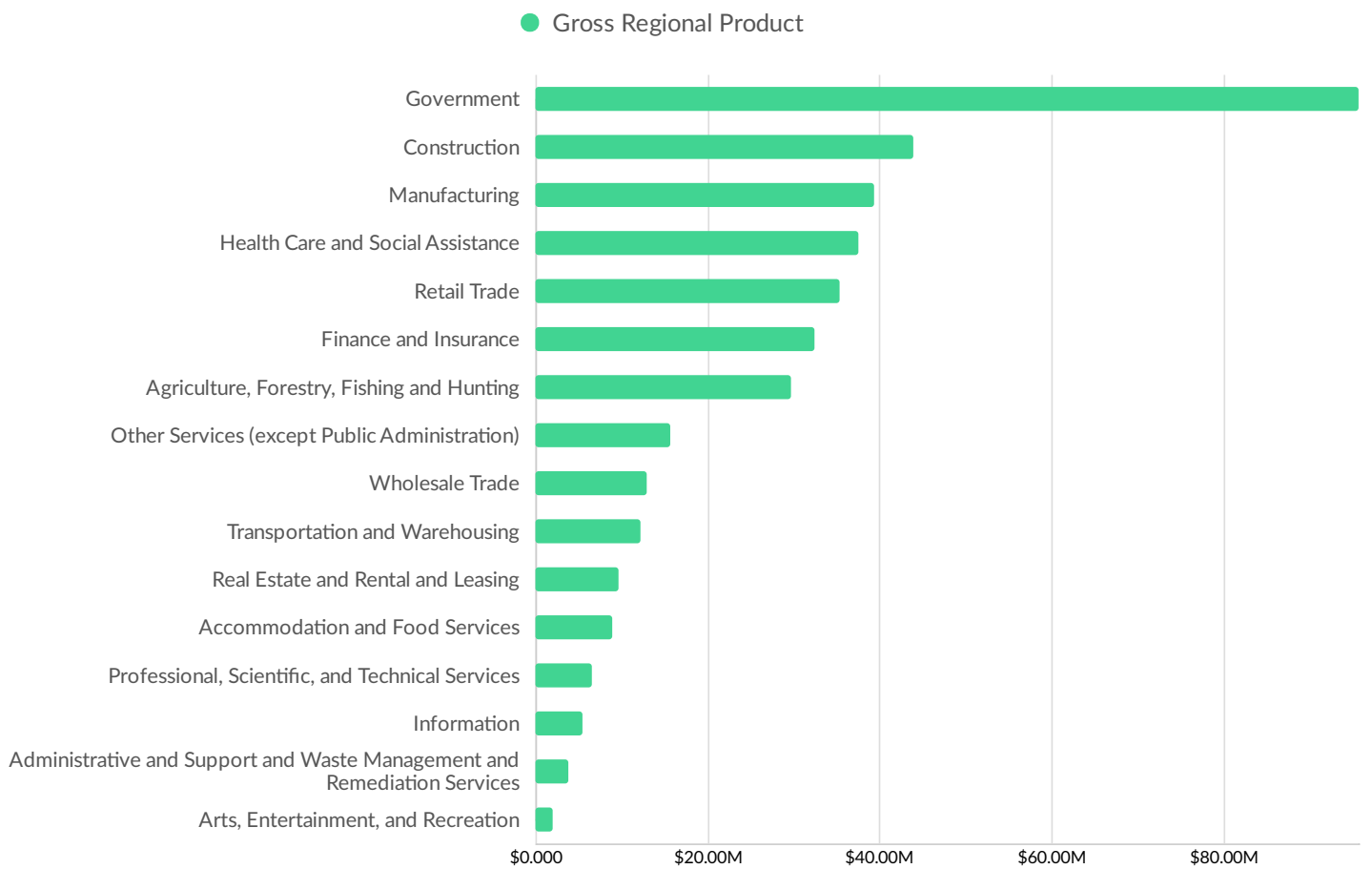

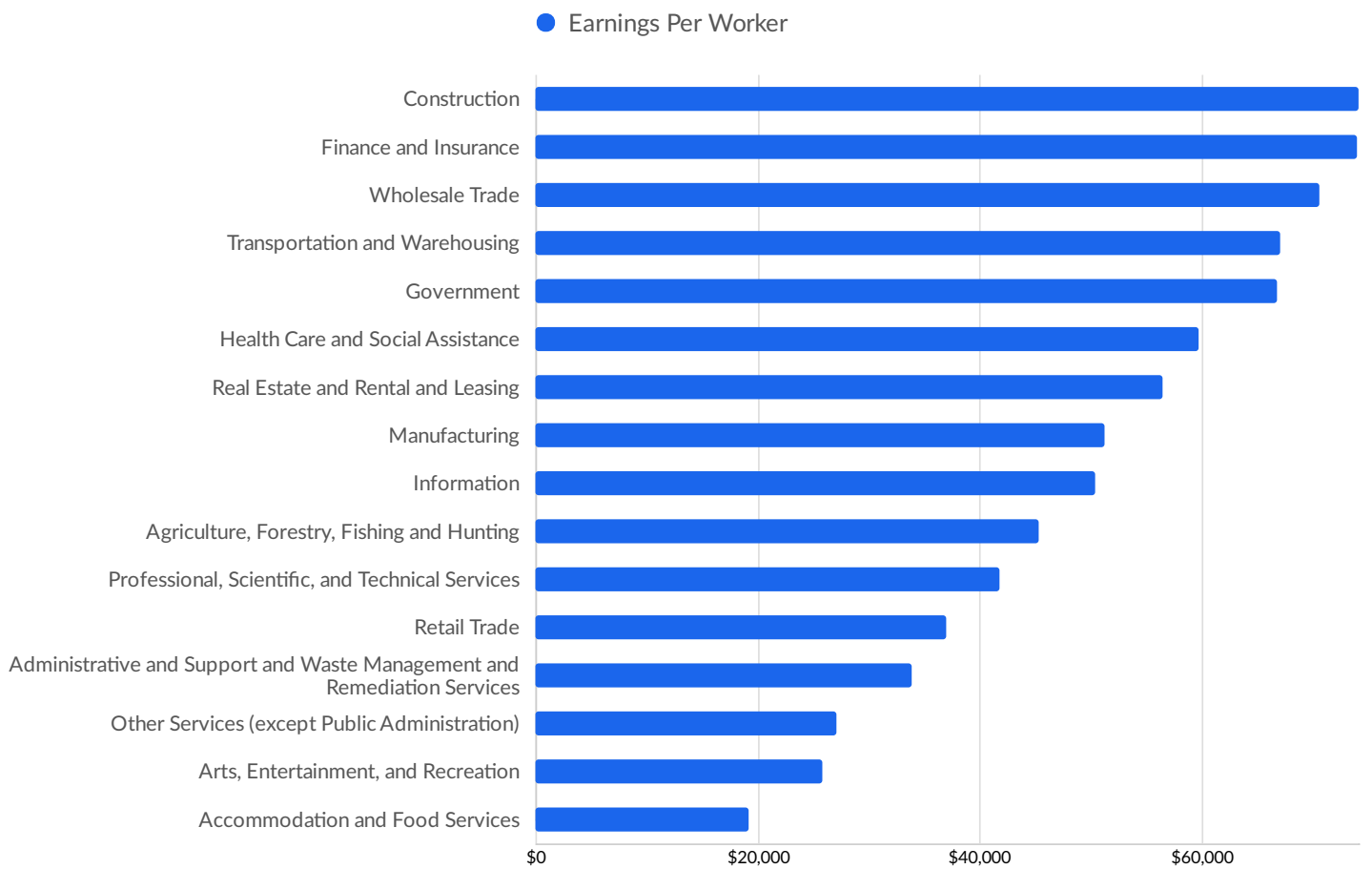
Top Industry Location Quotient



Top Industry GRP

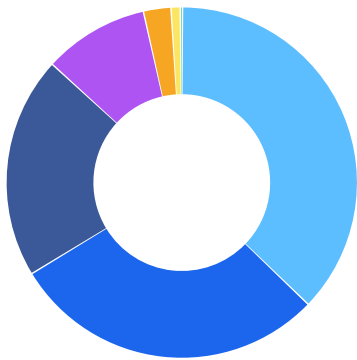

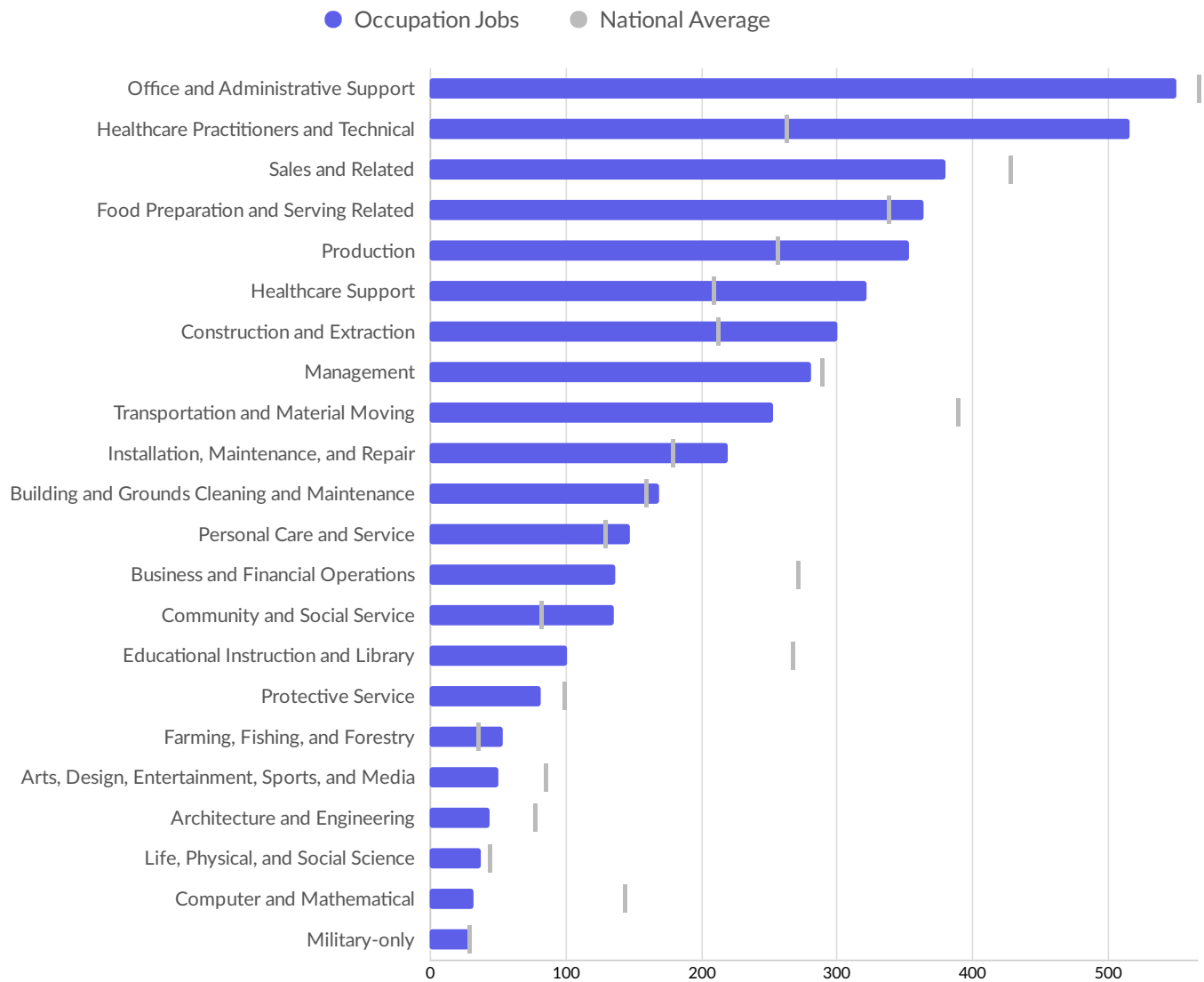

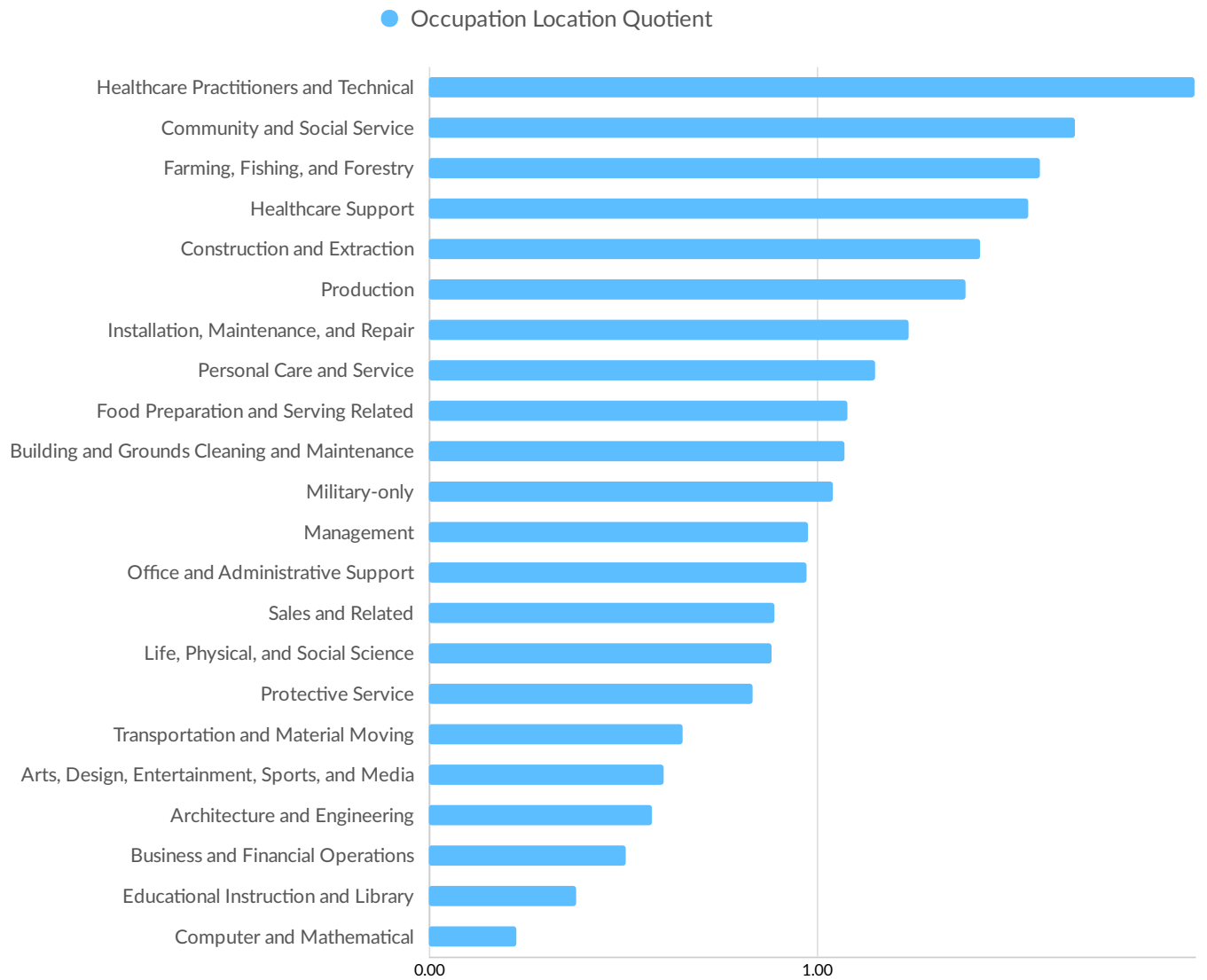
Largest Occupations



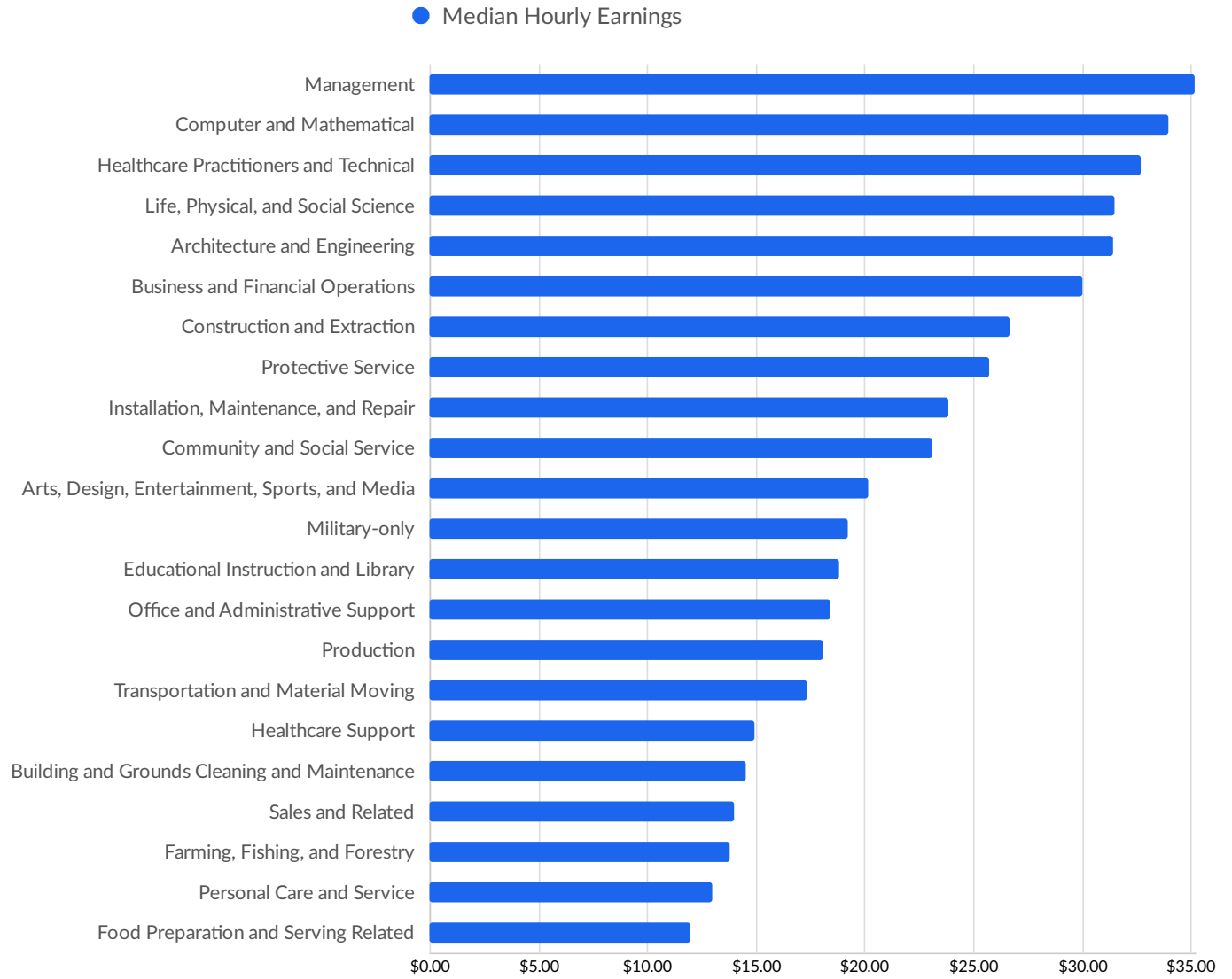
Top Growing Occupations
