With an artist's creativity and a keen business sense, Karla Overland, owner of **Cherrywood Fabrics** has positioned her company for long term growth. Using a



proprietary technique developed 30 years ago the small textile company produces a palette of high quality cotton fabric that has the look of suede. Cherrywood's solid colored fabric is used by quilters and fabric artists all over the world.

The company began working with the SBDC as Karla was transitioning from business partner to sole owner. Peter Nelson, SBDC Consultant, helped Karla analyze the financial impact and options for the purchase of Cherrywood Fabrics and guided her through that process. In addition, the company needed to find a new location that would allow them to improve production efficiency and meet future growth needs while fitting into their budget. The SBDC helped the company analyze space options and helped configure the layout of their production space to maximize efficiency.

"The SBDC helped me significantly as I purchased this business," says Karla Overland, "they assisted me in overcoming many of the obstacles that come with a buyout and expansion of a business."

The company has gained international attention through their quilting competitions and in 2016 they partnered with Disney to host a "Lion King" themed design competition. Overland credits Peter Nelson of the SBDC as being crucial in the process of the buyout and physical move of the business. 
