- **Existing Project:** There is a current Dislocated Worker (DW) grant in place for a specific company. That company has another wave of layoffs, and we decided to bundle that new round of layoffs into the existing DW grant.
- **New Project:** A company-specific grant set up to help workers affected by mass layoffs or closings, typically affecting 50 or more workers.
- **Small Layoff Services:** Workers interested in enrolling in DW can go to any of the state's Workforce Centers or independent service providers.
- **Suspend/Hold:** The layoff/closure is on hold or has been suspended.
