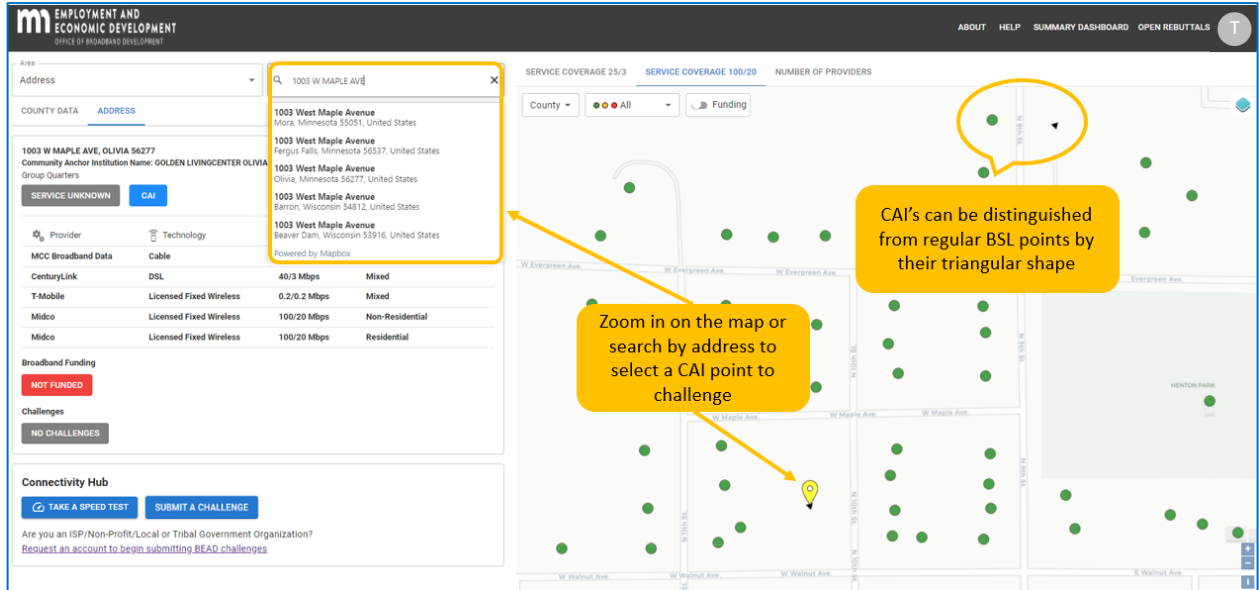


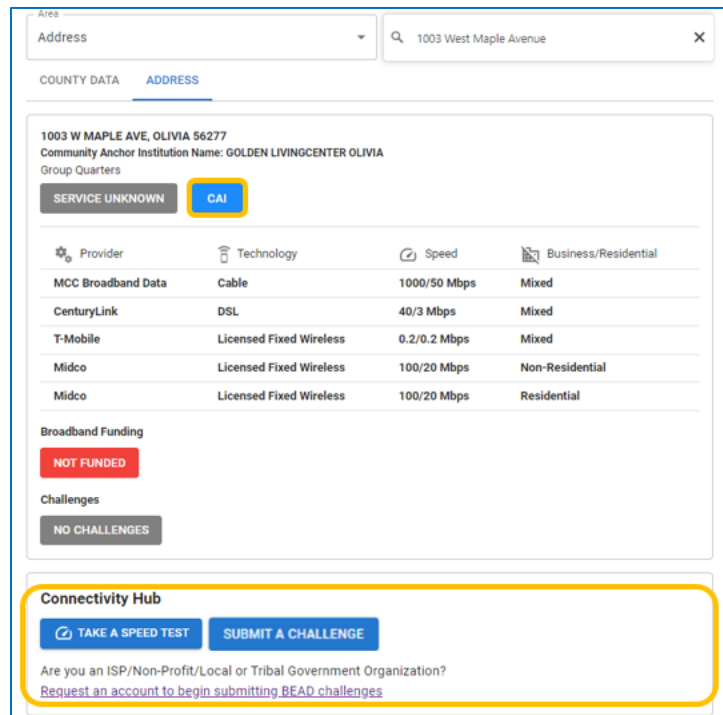
# Minnesota Broadband Navigator™

## How to Submit a CAI as an Availability Challenge

1. Search for the desired BSL by navigating the map or using the 'Search' function in the top left of the application.




2. Once you have your selected address, make sure that it is a CAI (you can do this by checking if the address has the blue 'CAI' box in the address information pane).



3. In the 'Connectivity Hub' pane at the bottom of the address information pane, click 'Submit a Challenge.'

- From the dropdown list, select either 'Location is a Community Anchor Institution' or 'Location is not a Community Anchor Institution.'




