Re: Announcement of Facility Closure

Dear Mayor Elliott and Mr. Grove:

We are writing to provide you notice that there will be a total closure of the Vollrath's Newport facility located at 910 Hastings Ave in Newport, Minnesota on March 27, 2026. The entire facility will be closed and all employees at the facility will be impacted. This closure is expected to be permanent. Most of the separations will occur between February 6, 2026, and March 27, 2026.

All affected employees have been notified (or will be) timely notified of their anticipated separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent.

The attached is a list of the job positions, names, and addresses of individuals who will be affected by the plant closing along with the anticipated schedule for job losses.

There will not be any bumping rights for the affected employees, that is, employees will not be able to displace more junior employees out of their job positions as a result of this closure.

There is no union representing affected employees.




