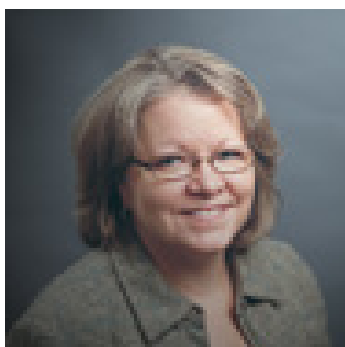


Notable leaders from around the country will share their recommendations for innovative long-term care financing options.

- Presenting will be keynote speaker **Marc Cohen**, Professor of Gerontology at UMass Boston and co-director of the LeadingAge LTSS Center. Along with Judy Feder, he has created a new national option for payment for long-term care.



- Other speakers include **Benjamin W. Veghte**, research director at Caring Across Generations. He was also the lead author of a report that created and developed a new approach to helping families across the generations with caregiving, called “Universal Family Care.”



- **Bea Rector**, director of the Home and Community Services Division in Washington State's Department of Social and Health Services, participated in leading the process to enact a state long-term care insurance option for state residents in Washington.
