

MN Medicaid State Plan Amendment 22-0029

DRAFT

This amendment will add a disregard under income and asset eligibility determinations for the following MA populations:

Disregard payments made to workers on the frontline during the COVID-19 peacetime emergency declared by the governor in 2020, authorized under *2022 Laws of Minnesota, chapter 50, article 2 sections 1 through 3.*

The disregard will be included in the eligibility determinations for the following Medicaid populations:

- Aged, blind and disabled groups, mandatory and optional
- Disabled child group
- Aged, blind and disabled medically needy group
- Medically needy for disabled children
- Medically needy for parents, children and pregnant women
- Medicare Savings Groups: Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries, Specified Low-Income Beneficiaries, Qualifying Individuals

The amendment is effective on 9/1/2022.

Note: The amendment will be made in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services on-line program known as MACPro, in multiple templates too numerous and complex to reproduce on-line.
