

SUMMARY

Medicaid State Plan Amendment
Approved] MN-23-0028

This approved amendment complies with the requirement to cover adult vaccines and their administrative costs under the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) of 2021. The IRA requires Medicaid programs to cover adult vaccines without cost sharing, when recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the Center for Disease Control, along with administrative costs. Minnesota has been covering these recommended vaccines without cost sharing.

In addition, this Medicaid State Plan page for preventive services will reflect current coverage for preventive services with an A or B rating from the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF). [Note: during CMS' review, text related to preventive services for pregnant women was removed, as that is found in another section of the plan.]

The following are preventive services covered without cost-sharing:

Any clinical preventive services that currently have a rating of A or B from the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF).

Approved immunizations recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and their administration.

Changes to ACIP recommendations are incorporated into coverage and billing codes as necessary to comply with revisions.
