

Your Medical Assistance Coverage During Pregnancy and After Birth Is Protected

Medical Assistance (MA) is Minnesota's Medicaid health insurance program. MA covers important care for your pregnancy, birth and care for the year after birth.

If you are pregnant, you are not subject to federal Medicaid changes.

This means:

- no work requirements,
- no copays and
- no six-month eligibility renewals.

To protect your MA coverage, update your pregnancy status with your navigator, county or health plan.

If you are currently enrolled in MA:

Are you newly pregnant? You may be eligible for extra benefits. Contact your county or Tribal office at mn.gov/dhs/health-care/county-tribal-offices/ and tell them if you are pregnant.

If you are not enrolled in MA:

If you do not have Medical Assistance, you may qualify if you are pregnant.
