Dear JEANINE Q PUBLIC6,

You are currently enrolled in UCARE Minnesota Senior Care Plus (MSC+). You are eligible to change your health plan for January 01, 2025 as part of Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS). **If you want to keep your current health plan, you do not need to return this notice.** If you want to change your health plan, continue reading this notice.

If there are other members of your household enrolled on Minnesota Health Care Programs, they will receive a separate AHPS notice.

MSC+ is a mandatory managed care program that administers your Medical Assistance health benefits through a health plan. You receive your Medicare benefits separately. Information on your MSC+ choices is as follows.
