


# 150th Anniversary

## Minnesota Security Hospital

What began in 1866 as a 210-acre farm has grown considerably since those early days. Today, the campus consists of 520 acres and 42 buildings with 1.1 million square feet. The campus employs about 1,100 people and has an annual budget of about \$110 million.


Here are some historic views of the buildings over the years.



Detention Hospital, later called Liberty Hall




Sheep graze in front of the main entrance
