Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS) Notice

Dear JANE K PUBLIC,

You are currently enrolled in BLUE PLUS Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO). You are eligible to change your health plan for January 01, 2024 as part of Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS). **If you want to keep your current health plan, do nothing with this notice.** If you want to change your health plan, continue reading this notice.

MSHO is a voluntary managed care program that combines your Medical Assistance and Medicare health benefits into one health plan. Keep reading for information on your current MSHO choices.

If there are other members of your household enrolled in Minnesota Health Care Programs, they will receive a separate AHPS notice.

Your health plan choices for January 01, 2024:

If you want to keep your current plan, you do not need to do anything.

If you want to change MSHO health plans, you will need to complete a separate enrollment form and return it to the health plan by December 01, 2023. Use the health plan contact information in this letter to contact a health plan that is available to you and request an enrollment form.
