Measures for MSHO/MS C+ Seniors Living in an Institution and All Ages

Use of antipsychotics for people with Dementia – MDS

*Structure and Process (S&P): Evidence of Physician Order for Life-Sustaining Treatment (POLST) with person specific goals for residents with 90 days or more stays – S/P

*Advanced Care Planning – MCM

Structure and Process (S&P): Follow protocol prior to sending to ED or inpatient – S/P

*Fall with Fracture (Fx) – MDS

Pressure Ulcers – MDS

Flu shots for Older Adults (FSO) – HEDIS

Pneumococcal Vaccination Status for Older Adults (PNU) – HEDIS

Advance Care Planning – MCM

*Use of High Risk Medications in the Elderly (DAE) – HEDIS

Annual Monitoring of Patients on Persistent Meds (MPM) – HEDIS SNP

Medication Reconciliation Post – Discharge (MRP) – HEDIS SNP
