VISITING RESTRICTIONS FOR VISITORS

Rule Violation	First Offense	Second Offense	Third Offense
1. Involvement in smuggling drugs, alcohol, other intoxicants, tobacco, weapons, simulated weapons, ammunition, or escape paraphernalia. Involvement in escape or attempted escape. Applies throughout the facility.	Administratively Banned from visiting in all Minnesota Correctional Facilities		
2. Smuggling or attempting to smuggle contraband other than listed above. Applies throughout the facility.	1 year ban	Indefinite ban	
3. Disturbances: Disorderly children on facility grounds.	Termination of visit and/or 1 month ban	1 month ban for each subsequent offense	
4. Refusing an authorized search in the visiting area.	Indefinite ban		
5. Abuse or threats (verbal or written) of staff, offenders, visitors, or others (including profanity towards visiting staff).	6 month ban	1 year ban	Indefinite Ban
6. Physical or attempted assault of staff, offenders or visitors, including children.	Indefinite Ban		
7. Inappropriate sexual behavior and/or physical contact in the visiting area (to include kissing).	Termination of visit and 3 month ban	6 month ban	Indefinite Ban
8. Masturbation, mutual masturbation, oral sex or sexual intercourse in the visiting area.	1 year ban up to Administrative ban from visiting in all Minnesota Correctional Facilities		
9. Falsification of information to obtain visiting privilege.	6 month ban	Indefinite Ban	
10. Visiting or attempting to visit with a false I.D. or under a false identity.	Administratively Banned from visiting all Minnesota Correctional Facilities		
11. Conduct or other indications that the visitor is under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or other intoxicants.	Termination or denial of visit and 1 month ban	6 month ban	Indefinite Ban
12. Visitor misconduct on facility ground (to include the physical punishment of minors).s	Termination or denial of visit and 1 month ban	6 month ban	Indefinite Ban
13. Unauthorized verbal or non-verbal communication not limited to perimeter fence, windows, or other barriers.	3 months ban	6 month ban	1 year ban up to administrative ban from visiting in all Minnesota Correctional Facilities
14. Video visit violations for acts such as illegal activity, sexual acts, assaults, any conduct that creates a risk to facility security.	3 months non-contact up to indefinite non-contact Including the loss of visiting privileges		

All sanctions 1 year in duration and longer will be annually reviewed by the facility visiting committee at the request of the visitor.

Administrative bans are not eligible for review for seven years from the anniversary date of the infraction.

Personal conduct may aggravate these sanctions.
