An application for a pardon or commutation previously considered and denied on the merits will not be considered again unless the following occurs:

1. The applicant submits an application for rehearing based on new and substantial information that was not previously considered by the Board; and
2. At least two Board members consent to a rehearing.

### Instructions

1. Complete all sections of this application. Sign the last page and include the county and state in which the application is signed.
2. Submit the application, and any attachments you wish to include, using one of the following methods:
  - a. mail the application to the Board of Pardons at the above address;

  - c. fax the application to 651-607-6770.
3. We will acknowledge receipt of your application.
4. Your application will be screened to determine whether it contains new and substantial information that was not previously considered by the Board. Applications that do not contain new information warranting rehearing will not be placed on the Board's meeting agenda for further review.

***In your application to the Board of Pardons, you will be asked to provide information that is classified as private and confidential under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. Be advised that the information may be discussed at a public meeting of the Board of Pardons and records from this meeting are open to public inspection per Minn. Stat. § 638.07. Failure to provide the requested information may affect the processing of your application and may result in its denial.***
