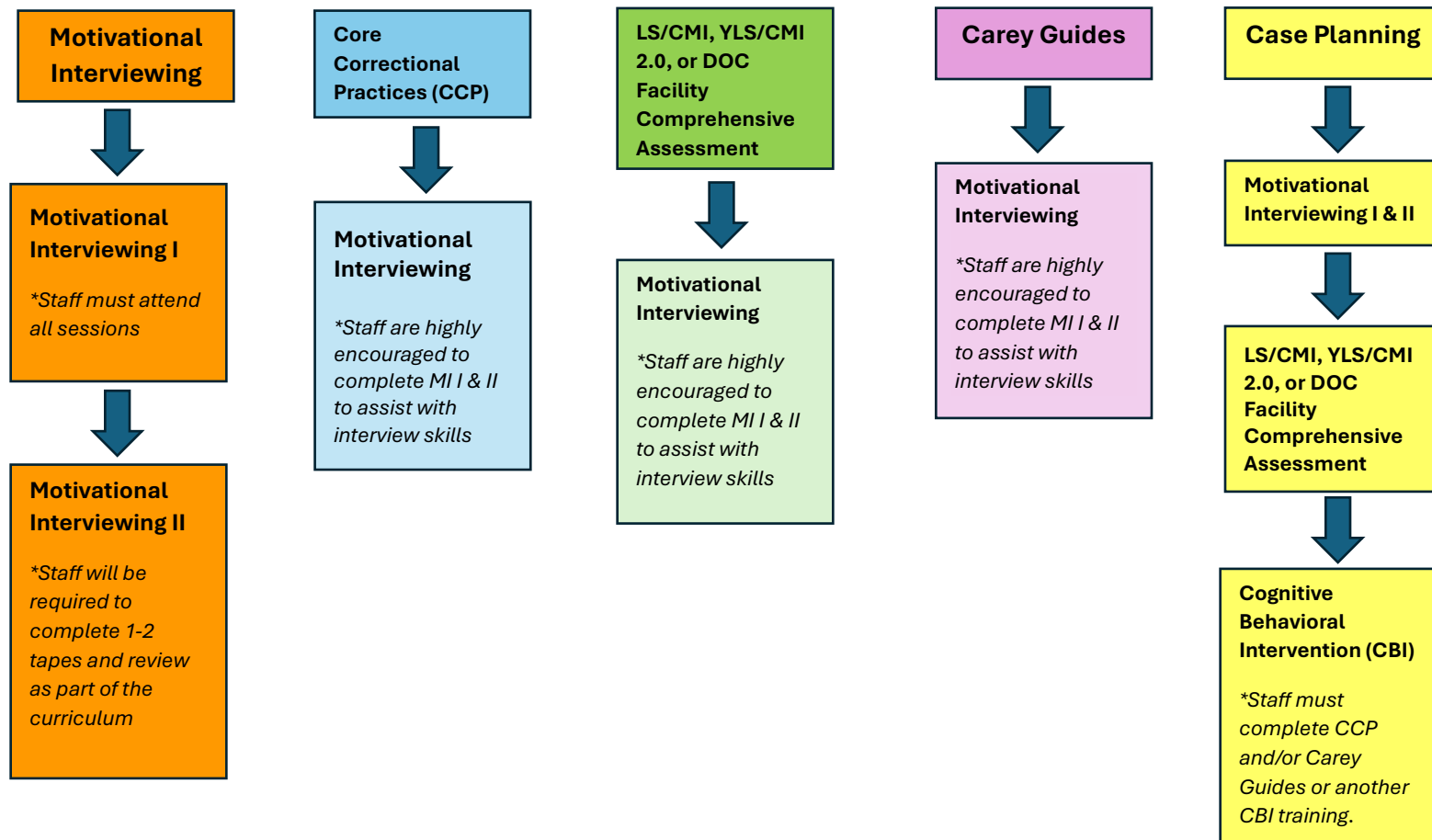


Evidence-Based Practices (EBP) Training Guidelines

General Guidelines

All participants must complete the Introduction to Evidence-Based Practices (EBP) online training in ELM before attending any EBP classroom sessions. Some training sessions also require mandatory pre-requisite courses. Please review the course descriptions and pre-requisites in the sections below.



Training Descriptions & Requirements

Motivational Interviewing – Level I (MI I)

- Participants must complete all sessions and meet all audio-tape requirements.
- Recommended as the first EBP training

Pre-requisite Checklist

- Intro to EBP certificate submitted to fs-training.doc@state.mn.us

Motivational Interviewing – Level II (MI II)

- MI I completion is required before registering.
- Delivered as:
 - Two half-day sessions (or modified for virtual delivery), or
 - Seven or eight coaching circles (agency discretion).
- Participants must complete all sessions and audio-tape requirements.
- After MI II, participants should continue skill development through QA processes (CoP, tape coding/coaching, refreshers, etc.).

- MI I certificate

Core Correctional Practices (CCP)

- Participants must attend all sessions.
- MI I & II is highly encouraged prior to attending.
- CCP or another Cognitive Behavioral Intervention (CBI) training must be completed before registering for Case Planning training.

LS/CMI or YLS/CMI 2.0 Assessment – Initial User Training

- Participants must attend all sessions.
- MI I & II is highly encouraged prior to attending.
- Completion of this training and the Intro to EBP certificate are required to receive access to the DOC S3 Portal.

Carey Guides

- Participants must attend all sessions.
- MI I & II is highly encouraged prior to attending.
- Carey Guides or another CBI training must be completed before registering for Case Planning training.

Case Planning for the Corrections Professional – Initial User Training

- Participants must complete all sessions and meet all audio-tape requirements.
- Participants must have successfully completed:
 - MI I
 - MI II
 - Assessment training
 - CCP and/or Carey Guides or another CBI training **OR**
- Participants may register simultaneously for any required courses they have not yet completed.

Accessing the Introduction to Evidence-Based Practices Training

- Required for all CCA, DOC, and CPO participants.
- DOC staff access the training through ELM.
- Non-state personnel must request an ELM user ID: [Non-state personnel ELM access request](#)

Trainer Expectations and Support

- Trainers across delivery systems are supported by the EBP Advisory Committee.
- Many trainers carry full caseloads; therefore, they are not responsible for following up with participants regarding requirements.
- Trainers will communicate concerns through the Training Coordinator, Kelly Wheeler, who will contact supervisors/directors as needed.

Participant Expectations

- Attend all scheduled training sessions in full.
- Actively participate.

Participants who refuse to participate or disrupt training may be asked to leave. Trainers will communicate concerns through the Training Coordinator, Kelly Wheeler, who will contact supervisors/directors as needed.

Trainer Standards

- Trainers are supported in maintaining quality, integrity, and fidelity in all EBP curricula.
- Trainers must meet expectations set by their trainer groups to maintain trainer status.

Statewide Training Availability
