#### Chapter 2960 - Mandatory Rules Not In Compliance

1. 2960.0080 FACILITY OPERATIONAL SERVICES, POLICIES, AND PRACTICES. Subpart 18.B.. Resident and family grievance procedures.

B. If a grievance is filed, the license holder must document the grievance along with the investigation findings and resulting action taken by the license holder. Information regarding the grievance must be kept on file at the facility for two licensing periods.

### Inspection Findings:

There were several grievances that had no documented administrative response. There were several that had no administrative signature or date documented.

#### **Corrective Actions:**

Training for the office administrator who files the grievances to ensure they don't get filed without administrative documentation. Administrators, effective immediately, will provide thorough documentation on all grievances.

#### Response Needed By: 07/31/2019

#### **INSPECTION COMMENTS**

This inspection was completed on July 10, 2019. It was determined during the physical plant tour that minor repairs are needed such as a hole in the wall repaired, graffiti in a vacant room fixed and a broken closet door fixed. It is also highly recommended that the facility put barriers on the handicap bars in the bathrooms.

There are issues with how grievances are followed up on and documented. I appreciate administrative support regarding an immediate change in procedures, as well as a willingness to train support staff to assure all grievances are addressed properly according to 2960. In addition, administrative staff will now monitor grievances for patterns with individual staff and if necessary, conduct internal reviews. The facility will also be changing it's policy that currently allows for side hugs, that will no longer be allowed.
