### RE: January MRRRA Update

This memo provides updated information about the Minnesota Rehabilitation and Reinvestment Act (MRRRA) and specifically addresses the policy and process for Earned Incentive Release (EIR).

#### Town Hall

A recently recorded town hall session with the Commissioner of Corrections is currently being shown on the institution channel within correctional facilities. We encourage incarcerated individuals with access to a television to view the recording to get the latest information on the MRRRA. #### Earned Incentive Release (EIR) process & Policy 204.064

The EIR policy has been approved and published. Please note, this policy is designed to address the process for earning incentive release for those who are admitted to prison *after* the policy goes into effect September 1, 2025. All those who are currently incarcerated or who come to prison between now and August 31, 2025, will be subject to the retroactive EIR process. Because the EIR policy is not in effect yet, the processes it outlines are not yet available.

#### Retroactive Earned Incentive Release (EIR)

An interim guidance memo on the eligibility criteria and process for retroactive earned incentive release is in the final stages of review and approval. Once approved, it will be shared, and we will begin piloting the process. MCF-Moose Lake and MCF-Shakopee have been identified as the pilot sites. **Those who are eligible for retroactive review will be contacted directly.** As a reminder, do not send a kite to your case manager asking if you are on the list for retroactive review.
