INSPECTION COMMENTS

The Nexus-Mille Lacs Family Healing Willow Trails located in Andover, MN, participated in the biennial inspection on April5, 2023, using Minnesota Rules, Chapter 2960, governing juvenile residential facilities. Sections of the 2960 standards that are applicable to this facility include: Administrative Standards, Group Residential, and Corrections. This facility does not use Restrictive Procedures. Inspection results are contained in the various sections of this report.

This inspection visit consisted of a physical plant inspection, including the intake area, all resident living areas including all resident bedrooms and bathrooms. The inspection also included discussions with administration and staff members, review of staff personnel and training files, resident files, review of daily logs, menus, resident rights, and other pertinent documentation.

The following comments are a result of the inspection. While these are not specific rule violations, these are areas that provided constructive feedback to help address potential facility issues.

Comments:

1. The cleanliness and condition of the house was exceptional. Staff and residents take pride in their facility/home.

2. There were no incidents of time-outs used, and no complaints and/or grievances filed in 2021 or 2022. This indicates that staff members develop relationships with the residents and are skilled in de-escalation techniques along with the use of their Empowering Restore Engagement program.

3. Supervisory staff conduct and document weekly reviews of well-being checks, therefore can address problem situations quickly.
