INSPECTION COMMENTS

The foster home looked clean. Bedroom walls, flooring and living area carpet is showing wear. The bathroom has a ventilation issue and needs to be corrected and cleaned. Resident files were in order. Foster parent training hours are up-to-date. On the date of this inspection, all licensing standards appeared to be in compliance.

MN compliance with the Family First Act will reduce the capacity for this foster home from 8 beds to 6 beds on December 31, 2020. If this facility desires a reduction in the capacity prior to December 31, 2020, they can request a capacity review in the Statewide Supervision System.
