INSPECTION COMMENTS

This foster home is clean and well maintained. The area in which residents reside offers an independent living area with kitchen and laundry facilities. This provides an excellent opportunity for residents to learn skills for independent living. This also restricts large age gaps between residents.

The home is operated primarily by foster parent and adult daughter of license holders, Jungjoo Hackbarth. The license is not transferable under DOC foster care licensing. Eventually this home will have to be re-licensed under the current foster parent by either DHS or DOC 2960 residential rules. Currently, the home houses residents under the extended foster care rule, which is acceptable under foster care licensing, but will be complicated and likely unavailable under the residential rule. While it is not required that licensure is changed immediately, it is important to plan for any unexpected cancellation of the current license in the event of a lack of availability of current license holders.

JJDPA Compliance

North Crow Group Foster Home is a six bed, nonsecure, family foster home for girls.
