Chapter 2960 - Mandatory Rules Not In Compliance

1. 2960.0070 ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCESS. Subpart 4.A.. Inventory and handling of resident property.

The license holder must inventory the resident's personal property, including clothing, and have the resident and the license holder sign the inventory upon admission. If the resident refuses to sign the inventory, two facility staff must sign the inventory. The license holder must ensure that a resident retain the use and availability of personal funds or property unless restrictions are justified in the resident's treatment plan. The license holder must ensure separation of resident funds from funds of the license holder, the residential program, or program staff.

Inspection Findings:

InspectionType :Biennial

One of three resident files reviewed showed that although the resident signed for inventory at admissions, a staff person did not.

Corrective Actions:

Ensure that both resident and one or two staff sign for the resident's inventory at admission per Rule 2960.

Response Needed By:

2. 2960.0090 DISCHARGE AND AFTERCARE. Subpart 3. Return of resident's property.

The license holder must return all of the resident's personal property to the resident along with a signed receipt upon discharge, unless prohibited to do so by law or case plan. Discrepancies between the resident's inventoried property turned over to the facility at admission and the property returned to the resident at discharge, and the resolution of the discrepancy, must be documented by facility staff.

Inspection Findings:

Review of three resident files showed that one resident did not sign for returned inventory at the time of discharge.

Corrective Actions:

Ensure that resident and staff are signing for returned inventory at discharge per Rule 2960.

Response Needed By:

3. 2960.0190 DISCHARGE AND AFTERCARE. Subpart 1.C.. Discharge.

The license holder must meet requirements of items A and B. C. The license holder must give written notice of the resident's projected discharge date to: (1) the resident; (2) the resident's case manager and parent, if permitted, or legal guardian; (3) the providing school district; and (4) the school district the resident will go to, if known.

Inspection Findings:

Review of three resident files showed that two of the residents did not have written notice of projected discharge date sent to the resident's team prior to discharge.

Corrective Actions:

Ensure that projected discharge date notification to the resident's team is sent in written form and a copy maintained in the resident's file per Rule 2960.

Response Needed By:

INSPECTION COMMENTS

The North Homes Boys Program biennial inspection visit was completed on September 19-21, 2023, using Minnesota Rules, Chapter 2960, governing juvenile residential facilities. Sections of the Rule 2960 that are applicable to the programs at this facility include: Administrative, Group Residential, Corrections and Restrictive Procedures.

At the time of this inspection, there were no residents in this program as all three North Homes residential programs have been combined due to low placements and staffing and updating of homes. Residents were living in the home until July 2023. This inspection period was for the years 2021 and 2022.
