Notice of Intent to Solicit Proposals for Sex Offender Programming/Treatment for Juveniles and Adults, Probationers and Supervised Releases for FY20-21.

The Minnesota Department of Corrections, Grants and Subsidies Unit is requesting proposals for the purpose of awarding grants for juvenile and adult, probationer and supervised release sex offender programming. Grants will be financed from funds made available through the Laws of Minnesota for 1994, Statutes 241.67, Subd. 1 and Subd. 3 (b) and Subd.8, and Statute 242.195, Subd. 1. Private, for-profit or nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations, public human service agencies, community corrections agencies, other governmental agencies and American Indian tribal governments that are able to provide direct sex offender specific services to juvenile and/or adult sex offenders are eligible to apply for these funds.

A Request for Proposal will be available by mail or electronically from this office. **A written request (by direct mail or electronically) is required to receive the Request for Proposal.** It is the respondents responsibility to both provide the written request and ensure the Request for Proposal is received. Submissions of Proposals must be received by mail no later than 4:30PM, April 12, 2019. **Late proposals will not be considered.** Fax or emailed proposals will **not** be considered.
