Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Discussion - Liz Richards & Gino Anselmo

- Gino and Liz discussed PREA within Minnesota Correctional Facilities focusing on advocacy, compliance, reporting, investigations, and education.
 - Since 2022, all PREA advocacy has transitioned to outside community-based agencies. 20 community-based advocacy programs around Minnesota have Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with DOC to provide these services.
 - MCF-Red Wing does offer advocacy services for juveniles.
 - These services are paid for out of DOC's budget, there are no grants that funds these services.
 - Screening is conducted within 72 hours of arrival to try and identify the likelihood of victimization or a potential abuser. Discussion on the personnel who are conducting the screening/intake process.
 - Annual Report is published by DOC discussing reports, responses, etc. This report is a very high-level look back at the last three years.
 - There is a three-year cycle for federal audits.
 - All individuals are provided education on PREA which includes a brochure and video which covers how to report and services. Instructional posters are also hung in a variety of locations throughout the facility.
 - IPs can make a report by calling the Ombuds Office, a 1-800 number and *77 to reach local advocates. Third party reporting is also accepted.
 - Allegations of abuse are handled by the DOC Office of Special Investigations.
 - Harassment investigations are conducted by facilities.
 - What is DHS's role and what do they do as part of PREA?
 - PREA section will provide the screening tools and screening protocols, as well as
 PREA Policies that are currently being revised.
