RE: Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary, or Duplicative Rules

This report is submitted pursuant to Minn. Stat. §14.05, subd. 5, which provides that agencies report any rules or portions of rules that are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative, as well as the status of rules identified in last year's report as obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative.

Minnesota Rule 2920 related to adult halfway houses was under review for proposed repeal and replacement. However, the review concluded that revision of Minnesota Rule 2920 was more appropriate. The rule has now been revised, and a draft rule has been obtained from the Revisor. The department will be proceeding with notice of intent to adopt the rule revision.

At this time, we can identify no other Department of Corrections rules that are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative and that should be repealed.
