Service Level: Specialized Advanced - Air

Terms of Specialized Advanced Air Ambulance License:

1. The licensee shall have available in pre-packaged and portable form, all required advanced equipment 24 hours a day for use on aircraft.
2. Registered nurses may substitute for paramedic attendants if the medical director of the ambulance service certifies that appropriate training and authorization in the use of all equipment carried on specialized advanced ambulances has been completed. Documentation of this training must be kept on file and submitted with licensure renewals.
3. All personnel must have completed training approved by the medical director in the physiological changes due to decreased atmospheric pressure, acceleration, vibration, and changes in altitude; instruction in the medical conditions requiring special precautions; and contraindications to air transport. A current statement, signed by the medical director must be kept on file and submitted with licensure renewals.
3. The licensee must have a Minnesota Department of Transportation - Office of Aeronautics, Commercial Operations License for the Ambulance Service. This certificate must be current and kept on file at the base of operations.
4. The licensee must have a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Air Carrier Certificate issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation. The certificate must be current and kept on file at the base of operations.
5. The license shall comply with all applicable statutes and rules governing air ambulance operations. (Minn. Stat. 144.801 - 144.8097 and Minn. Rules 4690.)
6. This schedule is subject to review by the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board at time of biennial license renewal.
