

Instructions for accessing, downloading, and saving for offline access of FMG documents on Android

In this guide you will learn:

- Where to find the downloadable FMG documents on the MFRC website
- How to download the documents to your Android device for offline access
- How to access the saved documents when offline

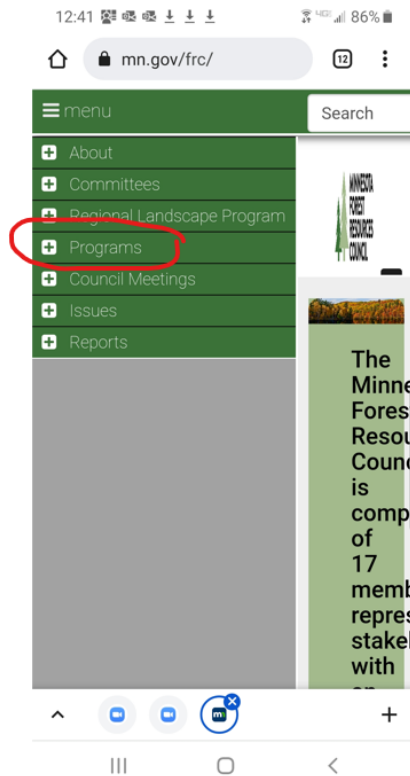
These steps to download the document must be done while online.

Open Google or Google Chrome browser and navigate to the MFRC website (<https://mn.gov/frc/> or search for Minnesota Forest Resources Council)

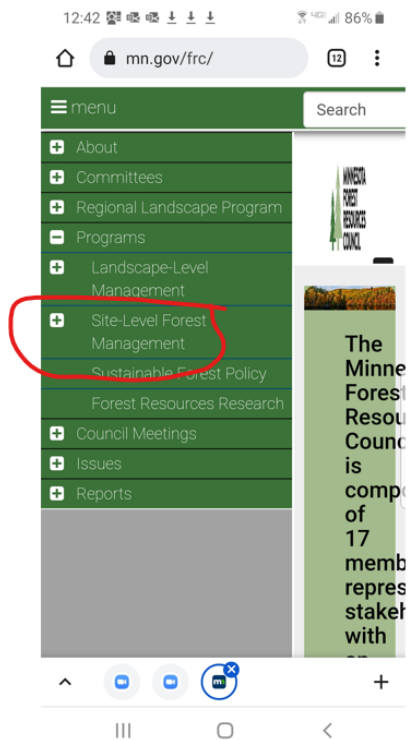
Once on the MFRC homepage, click “menu” in the upper left corner:



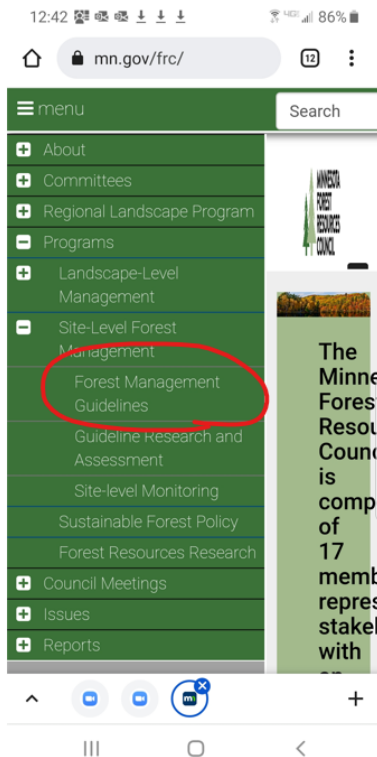
Then "Programs":



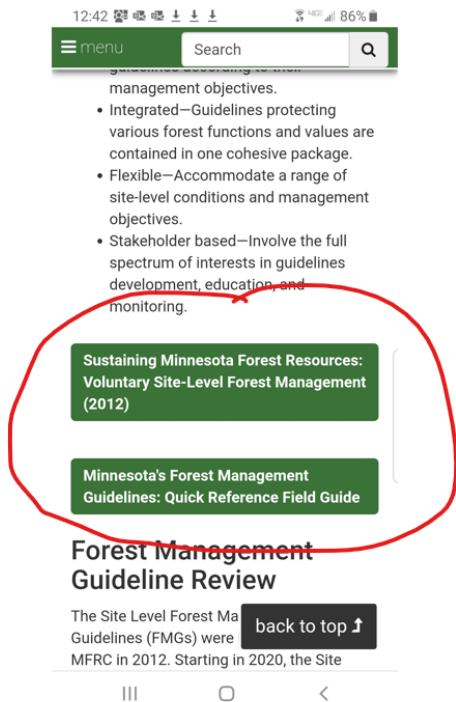
Then Site-Level:



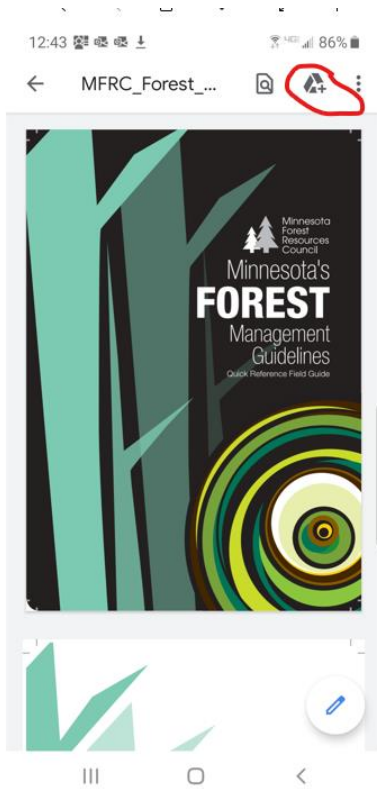
Then “Forest Management Guidelines”:



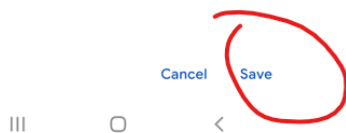
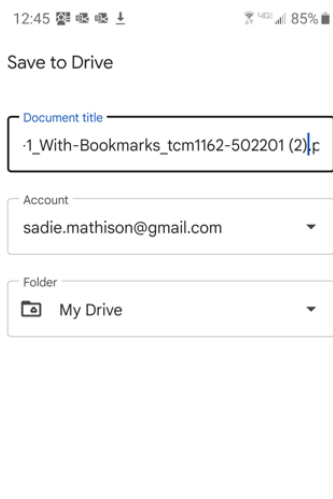
Scroll down on the Forest Management Guidelines page until you see green buttons for the full FMG document and the FMG field guide:



Select a button to open the PDF document. When the document opens, select the “Save to Drive” symbol:



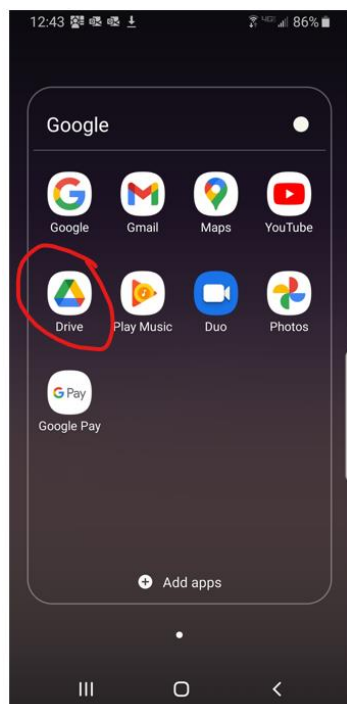
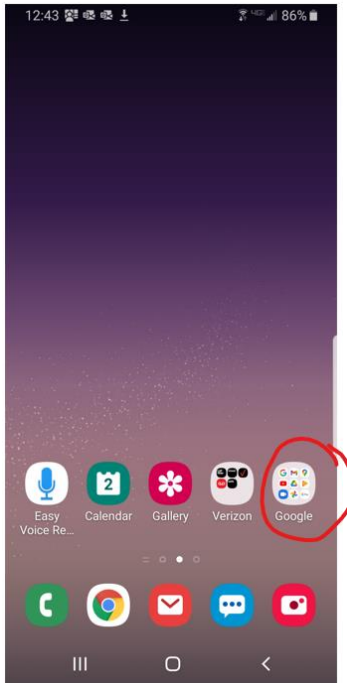
Then click “Save”:



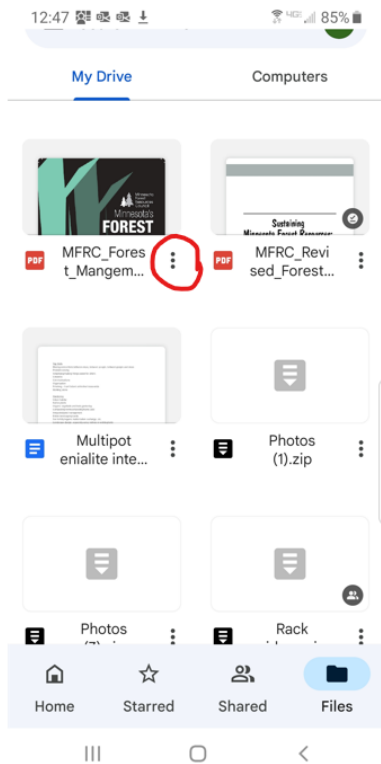
Repeat for each document you would like saved.

Now the PDF is saved to your drive, but you must go one step further to access the document(s) when you do not have Wi-Fi or a cellular signal.

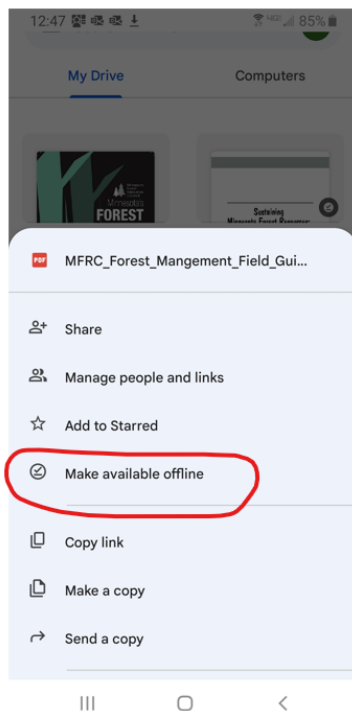
Find your Google drive app:



Tap the Drive icon to open your drive. When Drive opens, locate the document you would like to make available offline and select the three vertical dots next to it:



Select "Make available offline" from the menu:



Your document will now be available offline. Going forward, to navigate to the document, go to your Drive and just select the icon of the document and it will open:
