Rule title: Introduction of Education and Accountability Requirements on Licensed Organization's Chief Executive Officers

Chapter number(s): Minnesota Rules Chapter 7861

Describe the need for the rule and provide background information: At present, Minnesota Rules require that licensed organizations have a licensed gambling manager who has completed the GCB gambling manager seminar and who annually complete a continuing education course. Our newly proposed rule(s) would expand at least some of these obligations onto the organization's CEO.

CEOs of our licensed organizations maintain significant responsibilities when it comes to managing their lawful gambling operations. However, our Board and staff have found that increasingly, CEO's lack the same knowledge of gambling operations as gambling managers despite sharing in many responsibilities. Some simple, common-sense education for CEOs would go a long way in ensuring organizations maintain proper oversight.

Agency impact: Adopting this rule would mean the GCB would have to oversee compliance of another officer within licensed organization. The GCB would have to likely create new and edit existing educational materials for use with CEOs.
