Manufacturing standards for the design and manufacture of Multiple Chance and Multiple Seal Pull-Tab Games

The Minnesota Gambling Control Board (Board) is responsible for the regulation of lawful gambling in Minnesota as mandated under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349.

This document outlines the integrity/approval requirements for multiple chance and multiple seal pull-tab games. All multiple chance and multiple seal pull-tab games must meet the requirements contained within this document and the terms and conditions set forth in statute and rule for the manufacture and use of multiple chance and multiple seal pull-tab games.

MULTIPLE CHANCE/MULTIPLE SEAL PULL-TAB GAME REQUIREMENTS

All statutes and rules pertaining to the manufacture and operation of paper pull-tab games apply to multiple chance and multiple seal pull-tab games.

1.	Games must contain the manufacturer's name and logo.
2.	Games must contain the game name.
3.	Games must contain the form number.
4.	Games must contain the serial number.
5.	Games must contain the bar code.
6.	Games must contain a state of Minnesota symbol that is at least 1" high and 1" wide consisting of an outline of the geographic boundaries of Minnesota with the letters "MN" inside the outline.
7.	Games must contain the ticket count (ticket count does not apply to the chance tickets).
8.	Multiple chance games must contain a predetermined number of winning and losing tickets.
9.	Multiple chance games must contain predetermined number of qualifying winning tickets which provide an option to the player to forfeit the ticket for a chance ticket which may contain a prize greater than, equal to, or lesser than the qualifying winning ticket.
10.	Multiple chance games must contain a predetermined number of tickets designated as chance tickets or seals.
11.	Multiple chance games must contain prize amounts for the non-chance tickets that do not exceed the limits under Minn. Stat. Sec. 349.211 and 349.2113.
12.	Multiple seal games must contain a predetermined prize amount under a seal matching the qualifying pull-tab ticket. Ticket may/may not identify window to choose.
13.	Multiple seal game prize amounts may not exceed the limits under Minn. Stat. Sec. 349.211 and 349.2113.

MULTIPLE CHANCE/MULTIPLE SEAL PULL-TAB GAME - FLARE

All statutes and rules pertaining to the manufacture of flares apply to multiple chance and multiple seal pull-tab game flares.

	1.	The flare must contain the manufacturer's name or Board-registered logo.
	2.	The flare must contain the game name and serial number, which must be identical to the same information printed on the tickets in the deal.
	3.	The flare must contain the form number.
	4.	The flare must contain the ticket count (ticket count does not apply to the chance tickets).
	5.	The flare must contain the prize structure. Flares must accurately reflect winning combinations; no disclaimers for variations of winning combinations are allowed.
	6.	The flare must contain the cost per play (not to exceed the limit under Minn. Stat. Sec. 349.211).
	7.	For multiple chance games, the flare must state that a chance ticket includes the possibility of a prize greater than, equal to, or lesser than the qualifying winning ticket being forfeited.
	8.	For multiple chance games, the flare must contain a warning informing organizations that compromised security of the seals, perforations, or coverings containing the chance tickets requires immediate closure of deal.

9.	For multiple chance games, the flare must state the quantity of chance tickets and chance ticket prize amounts.
10.	For multiple seal games, the flare must state all possible seal results.
11.	For multiple seal games, the seals on the flare must be numbered.
12.	For multiple seal games, the seal prize must be on the back of the tab when uncovered.

13.	Chance tickets do not have cost per play printed on them.
