- WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota recognizes the vital role of farm families and celebrates their role through the Farm Family Recognition Program; and
- WHEREAS: Several families from various Minnesota counties have been named a "2014 Farm Family of the Year;" and
- WHEREAS: These families were chosen based on their contributions to the agriculture industry, their communities, and the State of Minnesota.
