# Proclamation

- WHEREAS: September 11, 2011 marks the 10th anniversary of the terrible terrorist attacks against the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS: In this tragedy, thousands of innocent people were killed, maimed and injured; and
- WHEREAS: Extraordinary bravery was demonstrated by police officers, fire and rescue personnel, other first responders, and American citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota have set aside this day to honor, remember, and mourn the victims of this tragedy with their families and friends.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all U.S. flags and Minnesota flags be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota, from sunrise until sunset on Sunday, September 11, 2011, as a mark of respect for the victims of this tragedy.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this ninth day of September in the year of our Lord two thousand and eleven, and of the State the one hundred and fifty-third.
