Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Blood clots can affect anyone, including otherwise healthy babies, children, adults, and even athletes; and
- WHEREAS: On average, 274 people die every day in the United States from blood clots; and
- WHEREAS: 100,000 to 300,000 deaths from blood clots occur each year; and
- WHEREAS: 600,000 non-fatal cases of deadly blood clots occur each year; and
- WHEREAS: The Garnet Foundation, a Minnesota based nonprofit organization, raises awareness and provides informational and educational resources to those affected by non-cancerous genetic blood conditions and those who would like to learn more about these conditions; and
- WHEREAS: More than 275 organizations in 65 countries are participating in World Thrombosis Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, October 13, 2015, as:

THROMBOSIS AWARENESS DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
