Proclamation

WHEREAS: Nearly 77,000 children in Minnesota, about 18 percent, live in families with incomes below the federal poverty level, and an additional 67,000 children live at or below 185 percent of the poverty level; and

WHEREAS: Local and national research shows that high quality early care and education settings can substantially increase the proportion of these children who start school ready to succeed; and

WHEREAS: Public policies that support early learning for young children are crucial to their futures; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota early care and education community, in partnership with the National Association for the Education of Young Children, are celebrating the Week of the Young Child, April 6-12, 2014; and

WHEREAS: These organizations are working to ensure healthy development for Minnesota's children by improving the quality of learning opportunities; and

WHEREAS: Professionals in the field of early childhood deserve thanks and recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 6-12, 2014, as:

WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD

in the state of Minnesota.
