# Proclamation

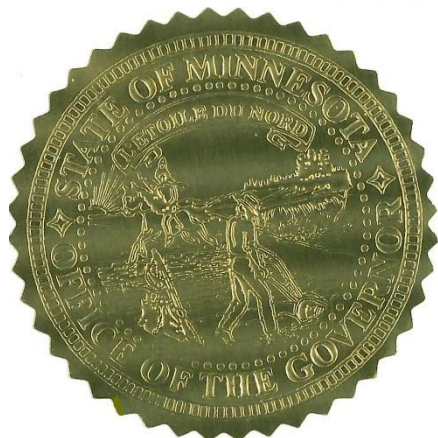
- WHEREAS: Minnesota proudly recognizes that our farmers have always fed our state, our nation, and our world; and
