Proclamation

WHEREAS: On Transgender Day of Visibility, we recognize our transgender and non-binary communities, demonstrating that we believe they should be treated with dignity and respect; and

WHEREAS: This annual day provides a forum to celebrate the lives and contributions of transgender, non-binary, and gender-expansive people, and raises awareness of their needs and the persistence of anti-trans prejudice; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota recognizes heightened discrimination against trans community members, who face systemic barriers and discrimination across health care, housing, employment, and education; and

WHEREAS: We recognize the compounded inequities transgender people of color face, reaffirming our commitment to ensuring they are seen, valued, and able to live full and safe lives; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has a proud history of supporting transgender people, protecting those seeking and providing gender-affirming care and barring conversion therapy for minors and vulnerable adults; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is committed to advancing equity by supporting and embracing transgender and non-binary people, and acknowledges that everyone is worthy of love and understanding.

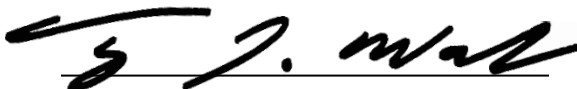
NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, March 31, 2026, as:
